3. Provide a character reference from one of your teachers
4. Submit the following application form, along with the Statement of Interest and Character Reference by February 13, 2017

Interview Process:

1. Each High School will select one candidate to be interviewed by the Rotary Club of Burnaby
2. Date of Interview: February 21, 2017 between 9am and 12 noon (details to follow)
3. Candidates from each high school will be interviewed by representatives of the Rotary Club of Burnaby
4. Interviews should last approximately 15 to 20 minutes
5. Candidates should have an understanding of Rotary and its priorities
