Additional English Requirements UBC

English Language Admission Requirements

✓4 years of study in English in Canada; 6.5 IELTS/ 90 TOEFL, or minimum of 70% in English 11/12

SFU

✓ 3 years of study in English in Canada, with a minimum grade of 70% in an English 11/12; 6.5 IELTS/ 88 TOEFL

Additional Math Requirements SFU

Quantitative & Analytical Skills Requirement

- ✓ Proficiency with 60% in Foundations of Math 11, Precalculus 11 or Math 12
- ✓ 70% in Foundations of Math 11, Precalculus 11, or Math 12 to register in Q course

Post Secondary Testing Requirements

IELTS

-International English Language Testing System required if schooling has not been in an English speaking environment for the last 3 or 4 years

TOEFL

- generally required if schooling has not been in an English speaking environment for the last 3 or 4 years depending on institution

P/SAT

-required by most American colleges/universities and for SFU Athletics Teams
