Lella Gandini is a native of Italy. She was connected early with the world famous Reggio Emilia educational approach, which focuses on fostering relationships and learning among children, teachers, parents and community. She would later become the point person for the approach in North America.

As Gandini describes the Reggio Emilia Approach: "The starting point is to be convinced that children have tremendous potential already when they are born, so that - in a preschool - rather than thinking 'What can I teach these children?' teachers observe and listen to children and construct learning with them."

She moved to the United States after meeting and marrying a professor at Smith College. She became an Italian instructor there while completing her Bachelor's degree and Master's degrees, and later received her Ed.D. from the University of Massachusetts Amherst. She is co-author of several books for parents and educators and author of many books of fairy tales, nursery rhymes and stories for children.

Come spend two days with Lella and The Wonder of Learning Exhibit. This is a rare opportunity to dig more deeply into the complexities of the Reggio Emilia experience as embedded in the exhibit with someone who is intimately familiar with these ideas. During our time together there will plenty of opportunity for interactions and dialogues as we consider, with Lella, how principles of the Reggio Emilia Approach can inform and inspire our own teaching here in British Columbia.

Take advantage of this unique occasion to be with one of the primary authors of the Reggio Emilia experience. One and two day are options available. Everyone is welcome, whether you are just beginning to be curious about the Reggio Emilia philosophy or have been engaged with these ideas for a while. Institute Description

Participants will be invited, both days, to begin the event in *The Wonder of Learning* exhibit. The mornings will be a combination of exhibit exploration and dialogue with Lella Gandini about the messages of the exhibit. Together we will consider the ways in which the exhibit gives visibility to connection and collaboration as related to the role of educators, encounters with materials and creative thinking. In the afternoon Lella Gandini will present visual stories to be interpreted also with the audience. There will be stories about children, teachers in the environment of the school, connecting with some of the many crucial aspects of the Reggio Emilia Approach, such as: the co-construction of knowledge through listening, observing, and supporting children's interactions in environments that are intentionally prepared; the use of pedagogical documentation as a tool for revisiting and interpreting experiences and for advancing learning and professional development; and the representation of ideas and hypotheses through many expressive languages as a way to communicate them to peers and adults.
