Adding images to your posts and pages follows very similar steps. It requires you to upload the image up to blog server and then insert into your post and/or page.

- **1.** Either add a new post or edit an existing post.

3. Just above the Post Content Box, there are the <u>Upload/Insert Options</u>. Click on the first box – **Add an Image**.



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4. The Add an Image uploader window will pop-up. Click on Select Files to choose an image you have saved.

6. Immediately it will start uploading with a progress bar. Then you will have the details of the image stored in your library. To insert the image in the post mainly focus on alignment and size.
