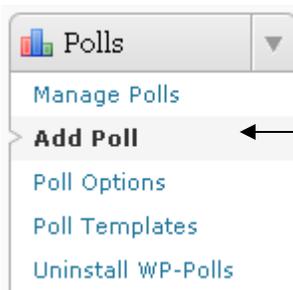


Adding a Poll can add some interest to your Blog, but also provide relevant feedback to current topics.

Creating a Poll



1. Log into your Blog Dashboard. At the bottom left you will see the new Poll Menu.



2. Click on the link Add Poll
3. Start off by filling out the Question you would like to ask and then the possible choices for answers.

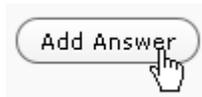

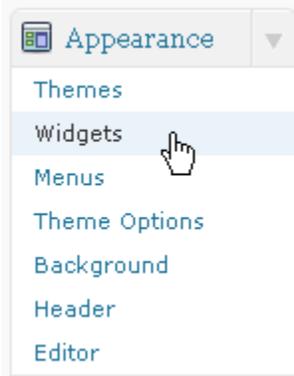

8. Now that the Poll has been created, you can add the Poll to the sidebar through a widget. Go to your Appearance Menu and click on Widgets



9. There will now be a WP-Polls widget in your "Available Widgets"



10. Drag this Polls widget into your "Widget Area"



11. You can adjust a few options here like showing a link to previous polls. I selected 'No'. Then click on Save.



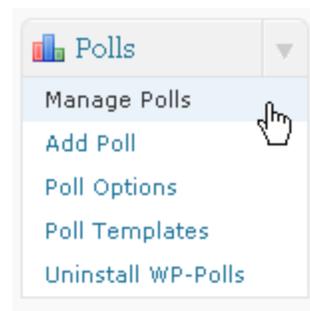
