

ROLES ASSIGNED IN BLOGS



Administrator

An administrator has full and complete ownership of a blog, and can do absolutely everything. This person has complete power over posts/pages, comments, settings, theme choice, import, users – the whole shebang. Nothing is off-limits, including deleting the entire blog. Only one administrator per blog is recommended!

Editor

An editor can publish, edit, and delete any posts/pages, moderate comments, manage categories, manage tags, manage links and upload files/images.

Author

An author can create, edit, publish and delete their posts. They can also upload own files/images. Our sd41 blogs have a layer of security; they can only delete their own images/content (not others).



Contributor

A contributor can create their posts but cannot publish them. When a contributor creates a post, it will need to be submitted to an administrator for review. Once a contributor's post is approved by an administrator and published, however, it may no longer be edited by the contributor. A contributor does NOT have the ability to upload files/images.

Subscriber

These are basic readers of your blog. They can comment on posts but these are held for moderation.

Readers

A reader can see and read those parts of the blog that are public.
