


# Using Meta Slider to Showcase Visual Story

Using Meta Slider can offer a dynamic way to showcase your images or text/images. The automatic movement provides a visual effect and can be used to create interest.


In your blog, go to **DASHBOARD**

Scroll down to **META SLIDER** and click



Click on **PLUS SIGN +** to create your slideshow

In the tab, name your slider collection




To add an image to your collection, click **ADD SLIDE**



Images can be picked up from your **Media Library** or use **Upload Files** (from your computer). \*Note: To speed this process, your images should already be resized to web quality.

Select the image you wish and it will appear on the right side with information about the image.


Click **ADD TO SLIDER**



## Using Meta Slider (p.2)

---

The slider will show the first slide. You can record a caption (which will show up at the bottom of your image when saved).




To Upload Files from Computer, click on the **UPLOAD FILES** tab.

Click **Select Files** and locate your image on your computer.

It will upload to your Media Library.


Click **Add to Slider**.



You now have 2 images in your slider.

Click **ADD SLIDE** to add more images.

(Note: it is a good idea not to go over 7-10 slides. If you have more images, use another slider.)



## Using Meta Slider (p. 3)

The right side of the slider presents information on the look of the slider and its movements.

Four options are given (Flex, R, Nivo, Coin). You can click **Save & Preview** to see each one.

Width and height is dependent on size of the theme of your blog. A standard 2 column theme usually offers 500 x 400 px or 400 x 300 px.

**Effect:** transitions between each slide

**Theme:** options

**Arrows:** allows audience to click left/right arrows to scroll themselves

**Navigation:** shows dot range at the bottom of your slider


### Advanced Settings:

Allow for more options.

**Slide delay:** default is 3000 ms or 3 seconds

### Usage

Provides a shortcode to copy/paste into your blog (useful if you plan on using it in a widget). However, a button appears on your page or post area to insert so you won't need this.





Copy & paste the shortcode directly into any WordPress post or page.



## Using Meta Slider (p. 4)

---

To insert your slider into your post/page:

Above your toolbar, click **ADD SLIDER**




Choose the **Meta Slider name** from the dropdown list.

Click **INSERT SLIDESHOW**



This produces a shortcode id where your slider will appear.



Add further content to your post or page.

Click **Publish**
