

# EPORTFOLIOS – Video

Video compression and conversion are skills that cross over to other avenues of life. There are many ways to address this – these are some efficient ways.

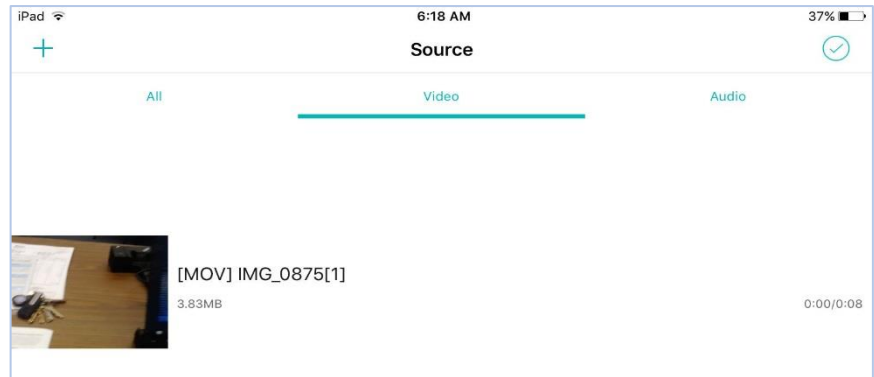
Idevice Apps (iConv; Compressor, Video Slimmer)

**iConv–Video Converter/Editor:** free version has ads (good opportunity to talk about AD popups); requires ios 8+

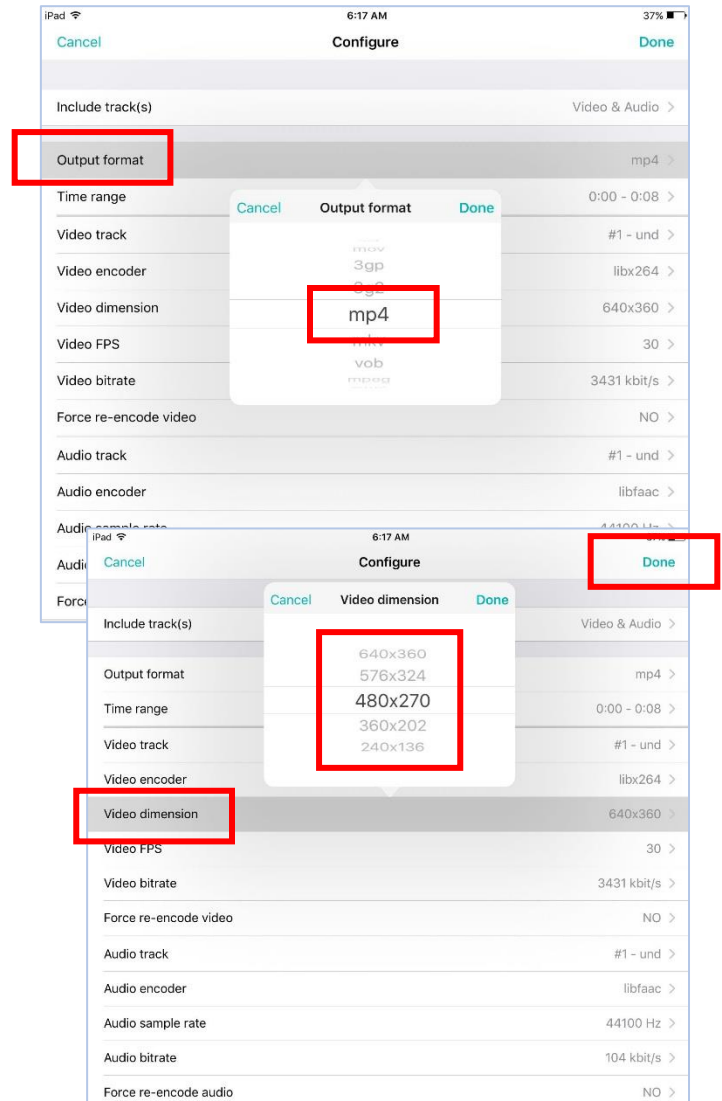
Launch app and click **+**

Locate video

(This video is .mov with file size of 3.8MB megabytes.)



**Configure > OUTPUT FORMAT > mp4**



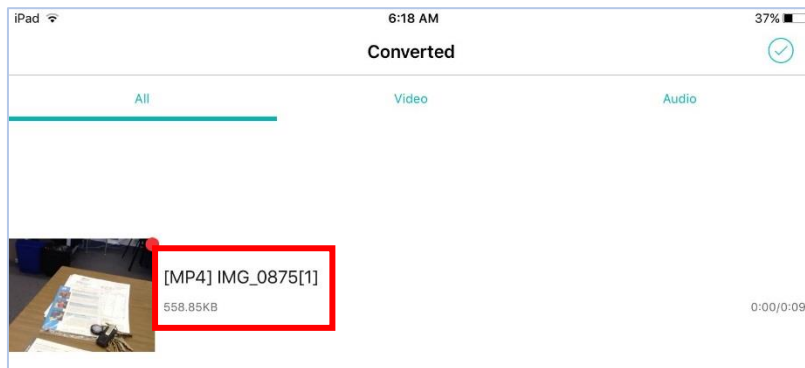
**VIDEO DIMENSION > 480 X 270**

(\*nice size for portfolio or blog)

Click **DONE**

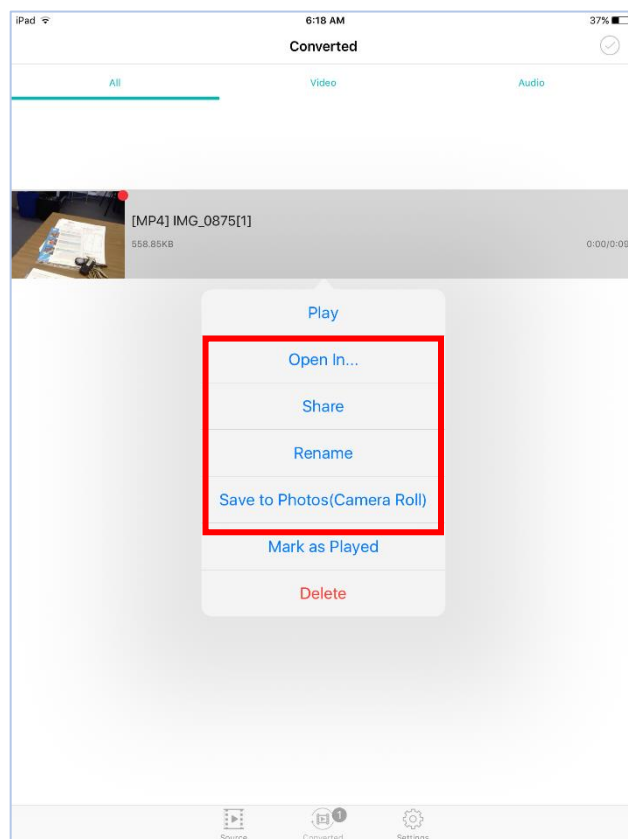
# EPORTFOLIOS – Video

In **CONVERTED** > the new video is now both converted from .mov to .mp4. Compression from 3.8MB to 558KB (kilobytes). Wow!



Last step: Select the video. **Save to Photos** to upload to portfolio/blog.

OR **Share** > sends to a number of apps



## UPLOAD TO EPORTFOLIO/BLOG:

Launch your eport/blog link app or access via Chrome browser.

Follow usual method of inserting content into a post.

# EPORTFOLIOS – Video

If videos are saved on the computer?

**AnyVideo Converter:**

Choose **Customized MP4**

**Basic Settings > File Name** (\*student names do not show what the video is about)

**Output Folder** > choose location (D drive is a good temporary drive)

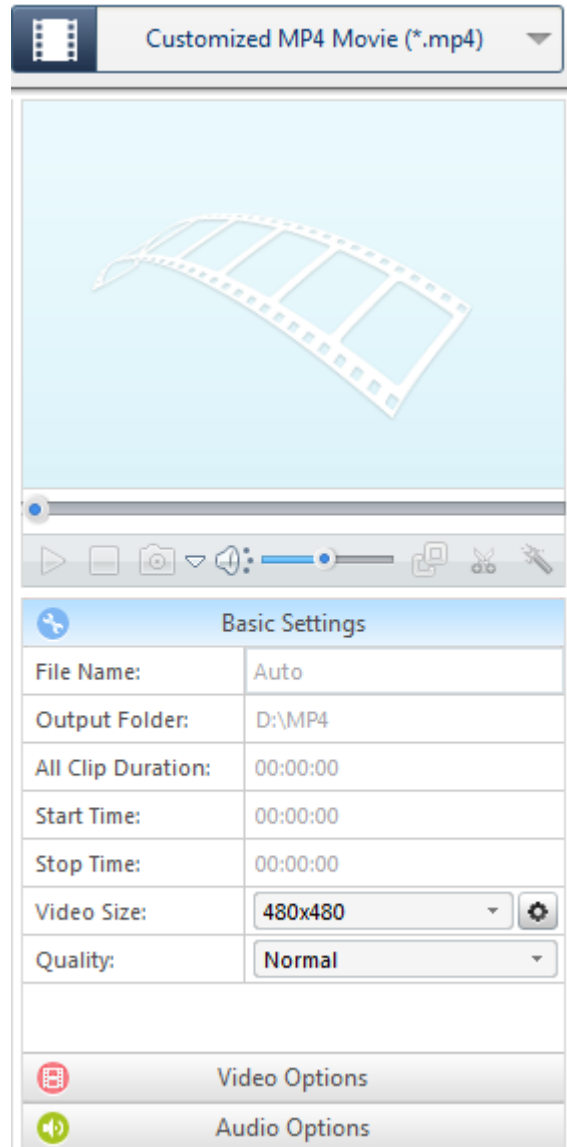
> **Video Size:** choose a size (480 x 320; 320x240 are all good sizes)

\*You can also edit or flip via the magic wand icon

## UPLOAD TO EPORTFOLIO/BLOG:

Launch your eport/blog link app or access via Chrome browser.

Follow usual method of inserting content into a post.



## Movie Maker

Add your video.

Edit if it is flipped.

Click **SAVE MOVIE** with a new name
