Work can be shared with individuals or whole class:

LAUNCH G-DRIVE

Open your classroom folder

If you are uploading several pieces of content (eg. images or multiple files), create a folder to house these resources.


Upload your content into this folder



In this example, I'm sharing pictures for students to use.


Folder> Images to work

Right click on the folder to get a **shareable link** to place in your assignment.

Copy the link. You will use this when you create the assignment.



Creating the Assignment is in your G-Classroom area


Use the WAFFLE icon (top right) to get to your G-Classroom


Hover over the PLUS SIGN and select Create ASSIGNMENT



Add Title, Instructions (optional)


Select **link icon** and paste in the link from your GDrive.
