

## Accessing Your Child's Blogfolio

Your child has a private blogfolio to communicate learning in a variety of ways. You are an important part of the learning process.

### Logging In

Your teacher will provide you with a unique id/pw to gain entry into your child's blogfolio. You can either wait until you receive an automated message link in your email or you can choose to access it at any time. Locate your school's website:

Go to **CLASSES or STAFF** > scroll down to the teacher > click on their website or web page.

Locate your child's name and click. (\*You might wish to bookmark this for future times.)

**LOG IN** with the provided USERNAME ID and PASSWORD. (\*If you are unsure, please ask the teacher.)

Click **LOG IN**


This will take you to the front page of your child's blogfolio.



## Accessing Your Child's Blogfolio

Select **EDIT MY PROFILE**




Scroll down to the bottom > **ACCOUNT MANAGEMENT**

Select **GENERATE PASSWORD**

Type in any password that you would prefer.

(Note: A strong password has a minimum of 6 characters with a number or symbol.)


Click **UPDATE PROFILE**

## See Your Child's Learning

Click on your child's name to flip between the front of the site and the back of the site.



This example shows 2 posts. They are by date order; the most recent one is first. As posts are published the area will continue to fill producing a grid-like effect.

## Accessing Your Child's Blogfolio

Clicking on the **TITLE** of a post will expand into full view.

You may see an image with written details or an audio recording or a video clip or a written piece of text.

Every post offers an opportunity to **LEAVE A REPLY**.

The **Comment** box is for you to respond.

Click **POST COMMENT** to have your comment saved.
