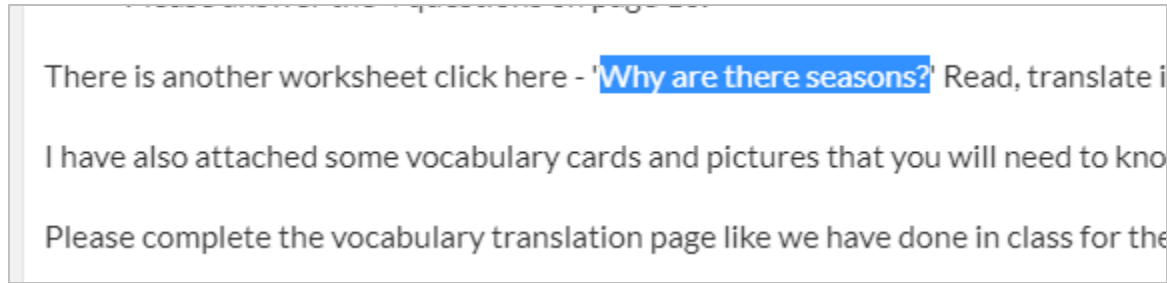
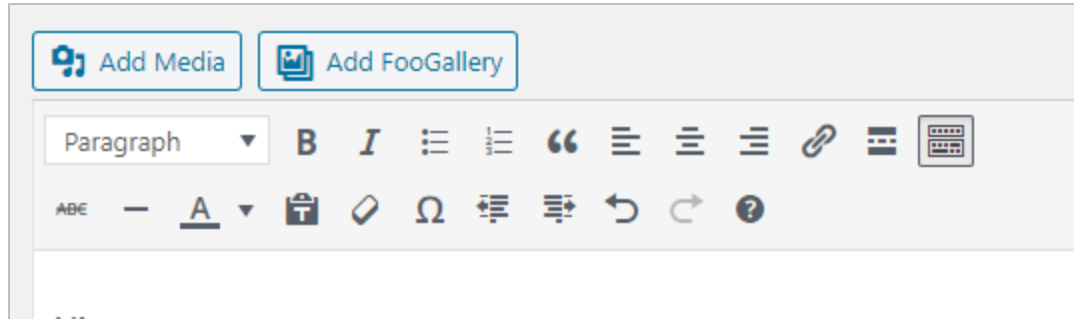


## Linking Media Already Uploaded to a Blog Media Library

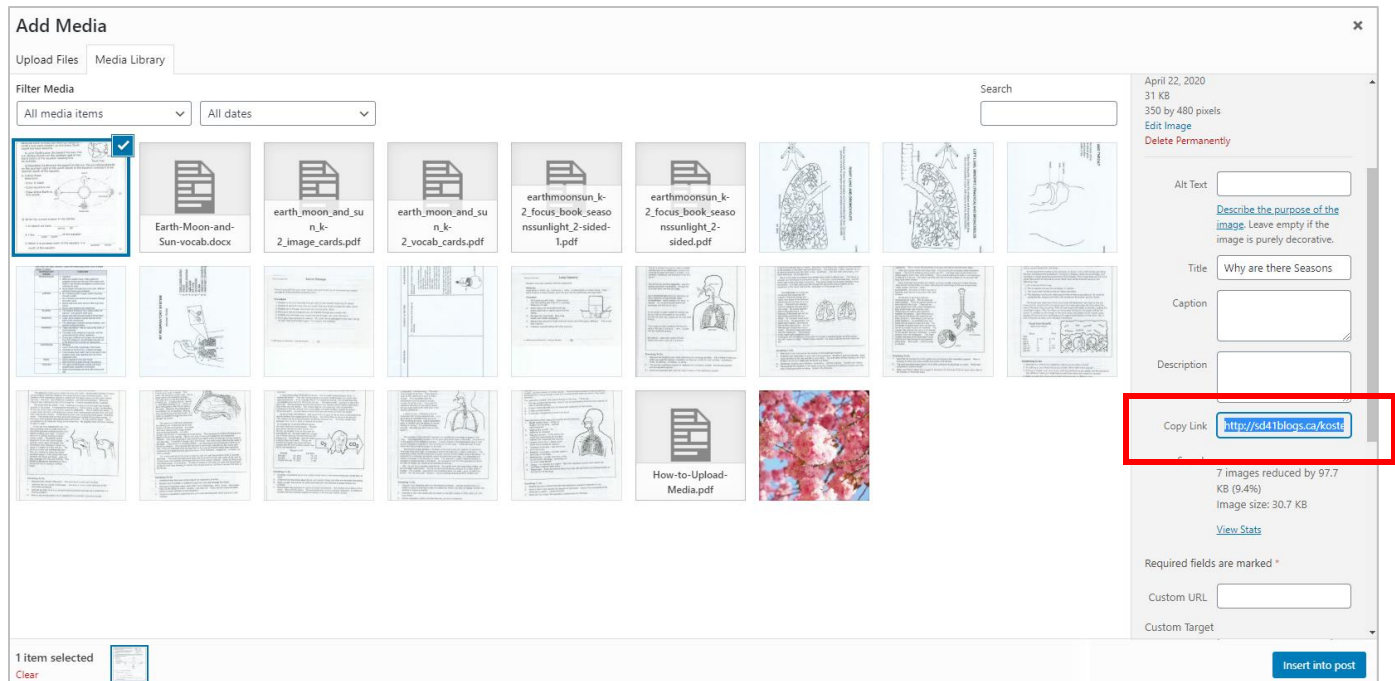
Highlight the word(s) you wish to link out to the image



Click **ADD MEDIA** button



You are taken to **MEDI LIBRARY** tab. If not, select it. Locate the image and select it.



On the right panel, **COPY LINK**.


Click the **X** in the top right to close the window.


