

Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) Workshop

This interactive session will explore how to use systematic assessment to select students for intervention and monitor their progress. A review of the coding and analyzing of reading behaviors and linking it to teaching will be covered. Participants will also be introduced to the LLI lesson frameworks and will learn how to teach each component of the lesson. The focus will be on the blue and green kits.

- New teachers who have LLI resources at their schools, but aren't familiar with how to use them
- Experienced teachers who need a review
- LSS and ELL teachers who want to learn more about LLI.
