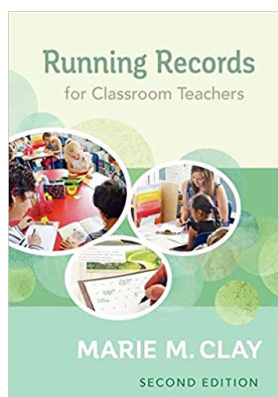
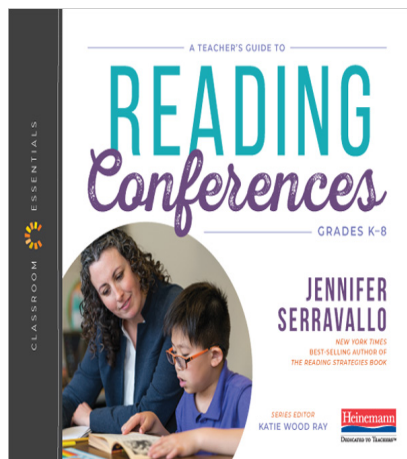


Implementing Running Records and Reading Conferences Series for K-7 Teachers

Running Records capture what children know and understand about the reading process. They capture children's thinking. Running Records provide you with an opportunity to analyze what happened and plan appropriate instruction. From Running Records, you have evidence of what the child is able to do, ready to learn, and learning over a period of time.

Conferences:

- provide individualized instruction for each student.
- provide insight into what the student is doing while reading and writing.
- helps the teacher investigate student knowledge.
- are a formative assessment tool.
- Provide reinforcement and/or enrichment of skills.
- Provide teachers with valuable information to plan responsively.
