GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

• STUDENTS NEED A MINIMUM OF 80 CREDITS (20 COURSES) IN GRADES 10 TO 12

REQUIRED (48 credits)

- A Language Arts 10
- Social Studies/Science Humaines 10
- Science 10
- Mathematics/Mathématiques 10
- Physical Education 10
- Career Life Education/Éducation À la vie professionnelle 10
- A Language Arts 11
- An approved Social Studies/Science Humaines 11 or 12
- A Science 11
- A Mathematics 11
- A Language Arts 12
- A Fine Arts OR ADST 10, 11, or 12

• At least 7 other courses in Grade 10, 11, or 12

ELECTIVES (Min. 28 credits)

• Can be from external credits or IDS courses

GRAD TRANSITIONS 12/ CAREER LIFE CONNECTIONS 11 (4 credits)

Career Life Connections 11 & 12 (2 credits each = 4 credits)

- 30 Hours of Work Experience
- Gr 12: Post-Grad planning & Capstone Presentation
- Gr 11: Attend in-school sessions & do assignments

PLEASE NOTE:

- A minimum of 4 courses (16 credits) must be at the Grade 12 level
- This includes 4 credits for a Language Arts 12 course, but does not include the 4 credits for Career Life Connections
- French Immersion students: Langue Seconde 10, 11, 12
- Grad 2020 No English 12 provincial exam; Numeracy Exam completion

 - MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST 30 CREDITS WITH SUFFICIENT GPA
- UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS
 - UNIVERSITY COLLEGES OFFER UNDERGRADUATE DEGREES IN A VARIETY OF PROGRAMS

BC COLLEGE ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- COLLEGE ACCEPTANCE IS BASED ON <u>BASIC GRADUATION</u> FOR MANY PROGRAMS
- CERTAIN PROGRAMS DO HAVE COURSE REQUIREMENTS
 - E.G., MINIMUM MARK IN ENGLISH 12
- COLLEGES ALSO OFFER UPGRADING OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADE 12 COURSES
- MOST BC COLLEGE ACCEPTANCE IS ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS, SO APPLY ONLINE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO SECURE YOUR SPOT
 - MANY COLLEGES OPEN APPLICATIONS ON OCTOBER 1ST

GENERAL UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- ENGLISH 11 AND 12
- SOCIAL STUDIES 11 OR 12
- MATH 11 (PRE-CALCULUS)
- ACADEMIC SCIENCE 11 (CHEMISTRY, PHYSICS, OR LIFE SCIENCES)
- SECOND LANGUAGE 11 FOR UBC (BEGINNERS LANG. OK AT SFU)
- PLUS ADDITIONAL ACADEMIC AND NON-ACADEMIC GRADE 12 COURSES
- BE SURE TO CHECK THE SPECIFIC COURSE AND MARK REQUIREMENTS OF SPECIFIC FACULTIES OR PROGRAMS
- ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS VARY –TOEFL AND/OR LPI MAY BE REQUIRED

UNIVERSITY ADMISSIONS IN B.C.

- ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR BC UNIVERSITIES (E.G. UBC, SFU) HAVE CHANGED FOR STUDENTS GRADUATING IN JUNE 2019 AND LATER.
- THESE ADMISSIONS CHANGES ARE A REFLECTION OF THE CHANGES IN B.C.'S
 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS AND CURRICULUM
- <u>BEFORE</u>: ADMISSION WAS BASED ON ENGLISH 12 + 3 ACAD. GRADE 12 COURSES (DEPENDING ON FACULTY). THIS WAS A SMALL SNAPSHOT OF A STUDENT'S PERFORMANCE AND ABILITIES.
- <u>NOW</u>: STUDENT PERFORMANCE IS VIEWED FROM A BROADER PERSPECTIVE (NOT JUST FOUR GRADE 12 COURSES), TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION GRADE 11 <u>AND</u> 12 COURSES (STARTING IN 2019 FOR UBC; IN 2020 FOR SFU)





- A MORE HOLISTIC, BROAD VIEW OF STUDENTS' PERFORMANCE, INCLUDING COURSES TAKEN IN BOTH GRADE 11 & 12
- UBC CONSIDERS BREADTH, RIGOUR, AND RELEVANCY OF COURSES, AS WELL AS GRADES IN ALL ACADEMIC COURSES, WITH A PARTICULAR FOCUS ON SUBJECTS RELATED TO A STUDENT'S INTENDED AREA OF STUDY AT UBC
- ADMISSION IS BASED ON:
 - 1. CORE ACADEMIC AVERAGE (DEGREE-SPECIFIC PREREQUISITE COURSES)
 - 2. OVERALL ACADEMIC AVERAGE (ALL ACADEMIC GRADE 11/12 COURSES, NOT INCLUDING ADST, P.E....
 - 3. PERSONAL PROFILE:
 - 5 TO 7 QUESTIONS WHERE STUDENTS REFLECT ON PAST EXPERIENCES, ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND CHALLENGES
 - OPPORTUNITY FOR STUDENTS TO TELL MORE ABOUT RELEVANT LIFE EXPERIENCES THAT WILL STRENGTHEN THEIR APPLIC.
 - NOT ABOUT SIMPLY LISTING ACTIVITIES, BUT BEING ABLE TO EXPLAIN WHAT YOU'VE LEARNED FROM YOUR EXPERIENCES
 - SAMPLE QUESTION: "EXPLAIN HOW YOU HAVE RESPONDED TO A SIGNIFICANT CHALLENGE THAT YOU HAVE
 ENCOUNTERED, AND WHAT YOU LEARNED IN THE PROCESS."

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS HAVE CHANGED FOR STUDENTS ENTERING SFU IN FALL 2019 AND 2020

- WHAT <u>HAS</u> CHANGED:
 - MINIMUM 5 ACADEMIC GRADE 12 COURSES WILL BE CONSIDERED IN ADMISSIONS DECISIONS
 - ENGLISH 12 MIN. 70% (*MATH 11/12 MIN. IS STILL 60%)
 - <u>SEPT 2019</u>: GRADE 12 COURSES CONSIDERED, MUST HAVE COURSES IN DIFFERENT AREAS (LIST A, B...)
 - <u>SEPT 2020</u>: ALL GRADE 11 AND 12 COURSES WILL BE USED IN ADMISSION EVALUATION
 - EARLIER APPLICATION DEADLINES (DEC 3: MAJOR ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS.; JAN 31: FINAL DEADLINE)
- 2019: ADMISSION EVALUATION IS BASED ON ALL APPROVED GRADE 12 COURSES (MIN. 5); WILL VARY DEPENDING ON PROGRAM AND FACULTY, WITH A GREATER EMPHASIS ON "LIST A" COURSES
- LIST A REQUIRED COURSES WHICH ARE KEY INDICATORS OF SUCCESS

SFU – STILL UNSURE?

TRY THE SFU "ADMISSION COMPASS"

STUDENTS CAN INPUT THEIR GRADE 11 AND 12 COURSES INTO THE COMPASS TO SEE WHICH PROGRAMS THEY ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR

US UNIVERSITY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- US UNIVERSITIES GENERALLY HAVE APPLICATION DEADLINES IN DECEMBER
 - THAT MEANS THAT EVERYTHING IS COMPLETED BY THAT DATE
- SAT/ACT EXAM IS REQUIRED FOR MANY U.S. SCHOOLS
- YOU WILL NEED TO ASK YOUR COUNSELLOR TO COMPLETE THE COUNSELLOR "SCHOOL PROFILE"
- YOU WILL ALSO NEED TO ASK TWO TEACHERS (MINIMUM) TO BE A REFERENCE FOR YOU
- PLEASE ASK **BOTH** YOUR COUNSELOR AND TEACHERS <u>WELL IN ADVANCE</u> OF THE DEADLINE
 AND PROVIDE THEM WITH AS MUCH INFORMATION ABOUT YOURSELF AS POSSIBLE
 - E.G., GIVE THEM A COPY OF YOUR <u>SCHOLARSHIP RESUME</u>
 - THIS WAY YOUR LETTERS CAN BE CRAFTED TO YOUR STRENGTHS
