Bursary Application Requirements and Eligibility

- 1. Bursaries shall be awarded by the South Burnaby Metro Club to any successful candidate who, for three or more years, has played on a team within the Club.
- 2. Bursaries shall be awarded to students proceeding from high school to any college, university or other post-secondary institution approved by the Bursary Committee.
- 3. Candidates must complete the application in full (attach additional sheets, if necessary) and provide all required information, documents and letters in order for their application to be considered. The information requested on the application indicates the criteria to be considered by the Bursary Committee.
- 4. Bursaries are conditional, in that the funds will be withheld until such time as the recipient provides proof that he/she is attending a post-secondary institution approved by the Bursary Committee.
- 5. A candidate must have a minimum C+ average in his/her marks.
- 6. A candidate must have demonstrated good citizenship, character and leadership (school and/or club involvement.)
- 7. The following must accompany the application:
 - a) A transcript of the student's marks or a photocopy of the Permanent Record.
 - i. If neither is available, a typed copy of the Permanent Record Card verified by a school official signature will be accepted. Current Christmas and Easter marks should be attached if available.
 - Letter(s) from a club/team official and/or school/community leader, indicating the candidate's character, leadership examples, participation in community activities, as well as information regarding the candidate's sports abilities or other team involvement.

PLEASE NOTE

- 8. It is the responsibility of the candidate to see that the application is complete and that all required information, documentation and letters are enclosed with the application.
- 9. The Bursary Selection Committee will not enter into correspondence with any scholarship applicant or his/her agent. The decision of the Committee is final.
