Community Leadership Scholarship 2026

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

This scholarship is awarded annually to a well-rounded student who has demonstrated strong citizenship and leadership skills as demonstrated through voluntary participation in community and school activities. The scholarship shall be applicable towards post-secondary education or trades training at any approved institution.

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for this scholarship, applicant students should have:

- demonstrated good citizenship and strong leadership skills.
- been actively involved in community service and / or volunteer work.
- been actively involved in youth initiatives, activities and events in the Burnaby community.
- been actively involved in school-based activities; and
- actively pursuing relevant school coursework.

GUIDELINES

1. A scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a Senior Secondary student in the Burnaby School District. Funds will be administered through the Rotary Club of Burnaby - Deer Lake.
2. In order to be eligible for consideration:
 - a. A student must complete a personal application; or
 - b. A staff member at the student's school must submit a nomination form.

4. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Scholarship Committee established by the Rotary Club of Burnaby - Deer Lake. In addition to the Rotary Club's scholarship criteria, applicants should be aware that in cooperation with The Vancouver Transportation Foundation additional funds may be available. These may be available to students who meet the Rotary criteria and additionally are interested in a career in transportation, commerce, or related businesses.
