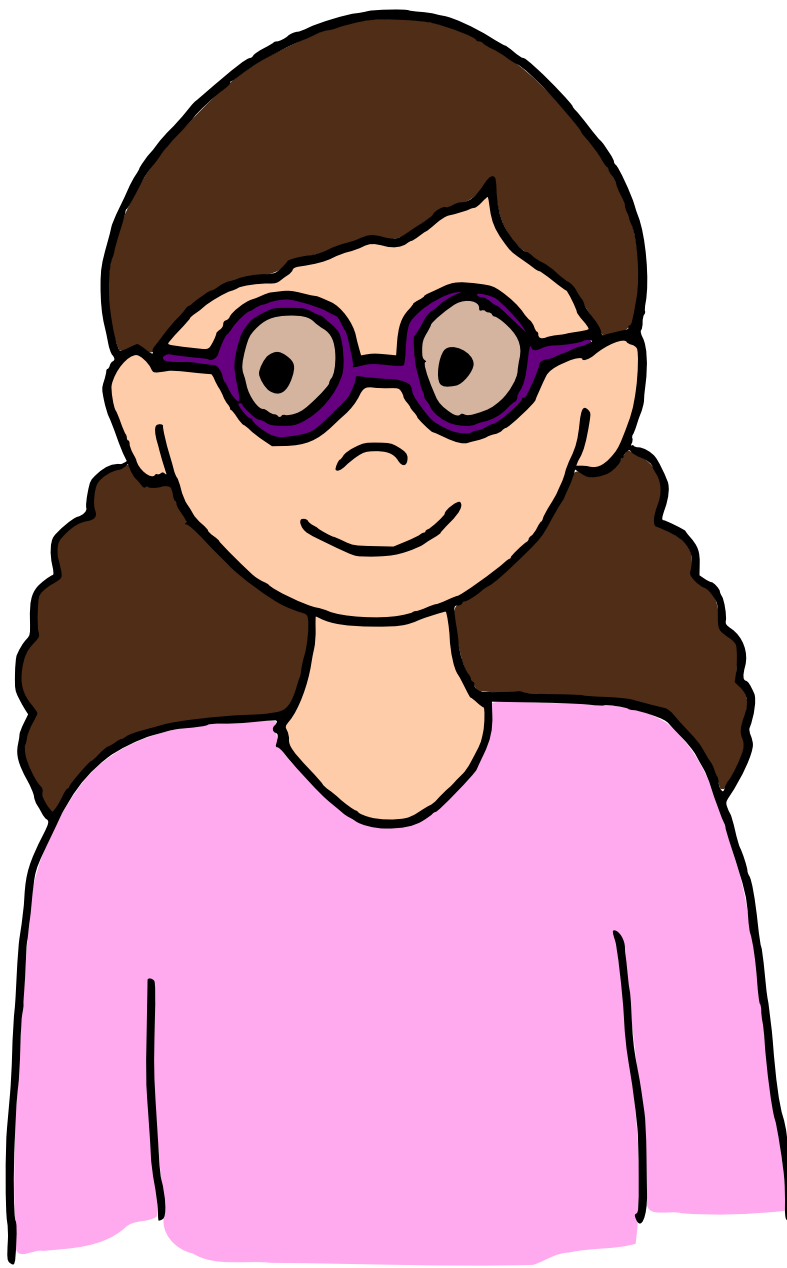


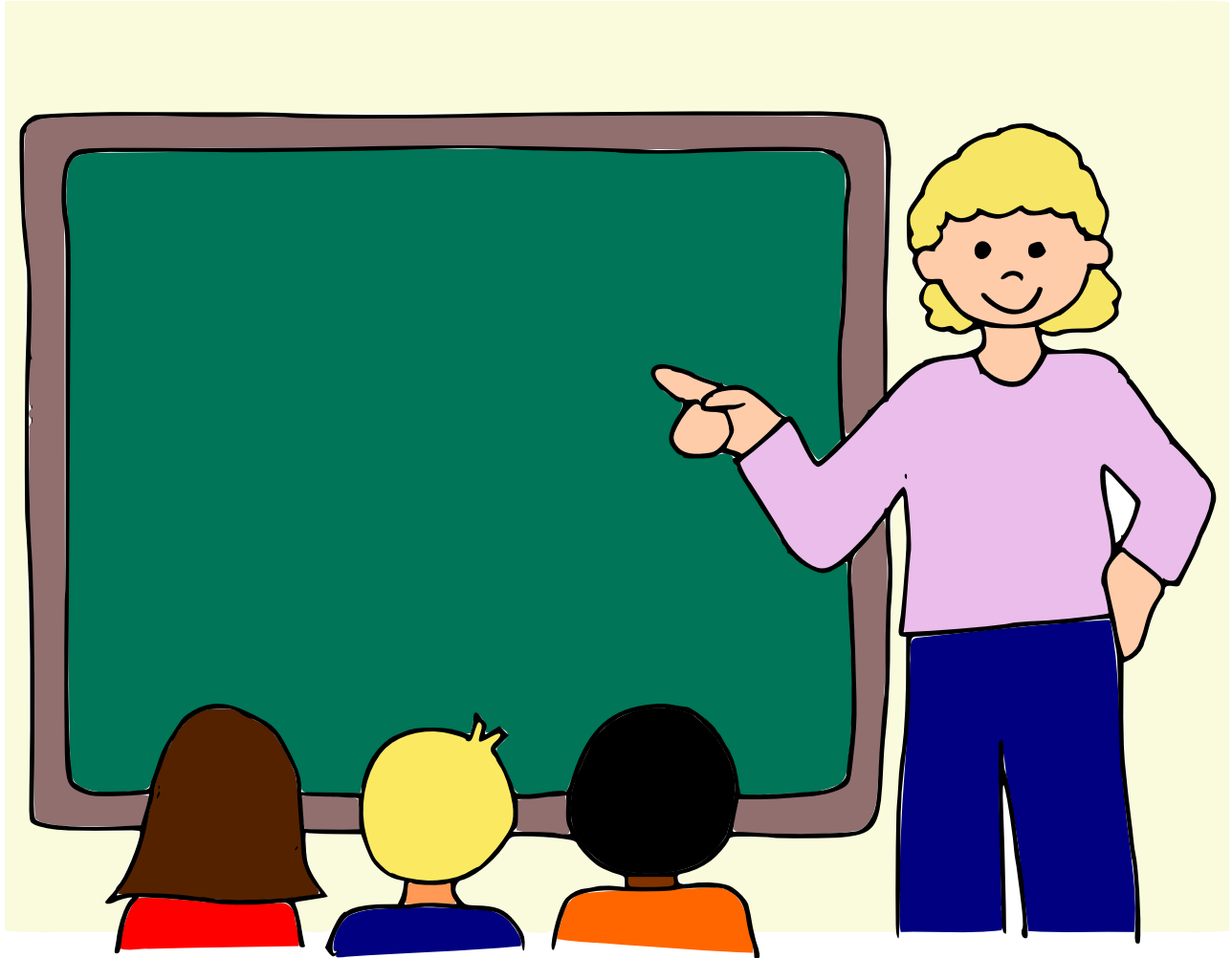
Jobs at School



My teacher has a job to do at school.



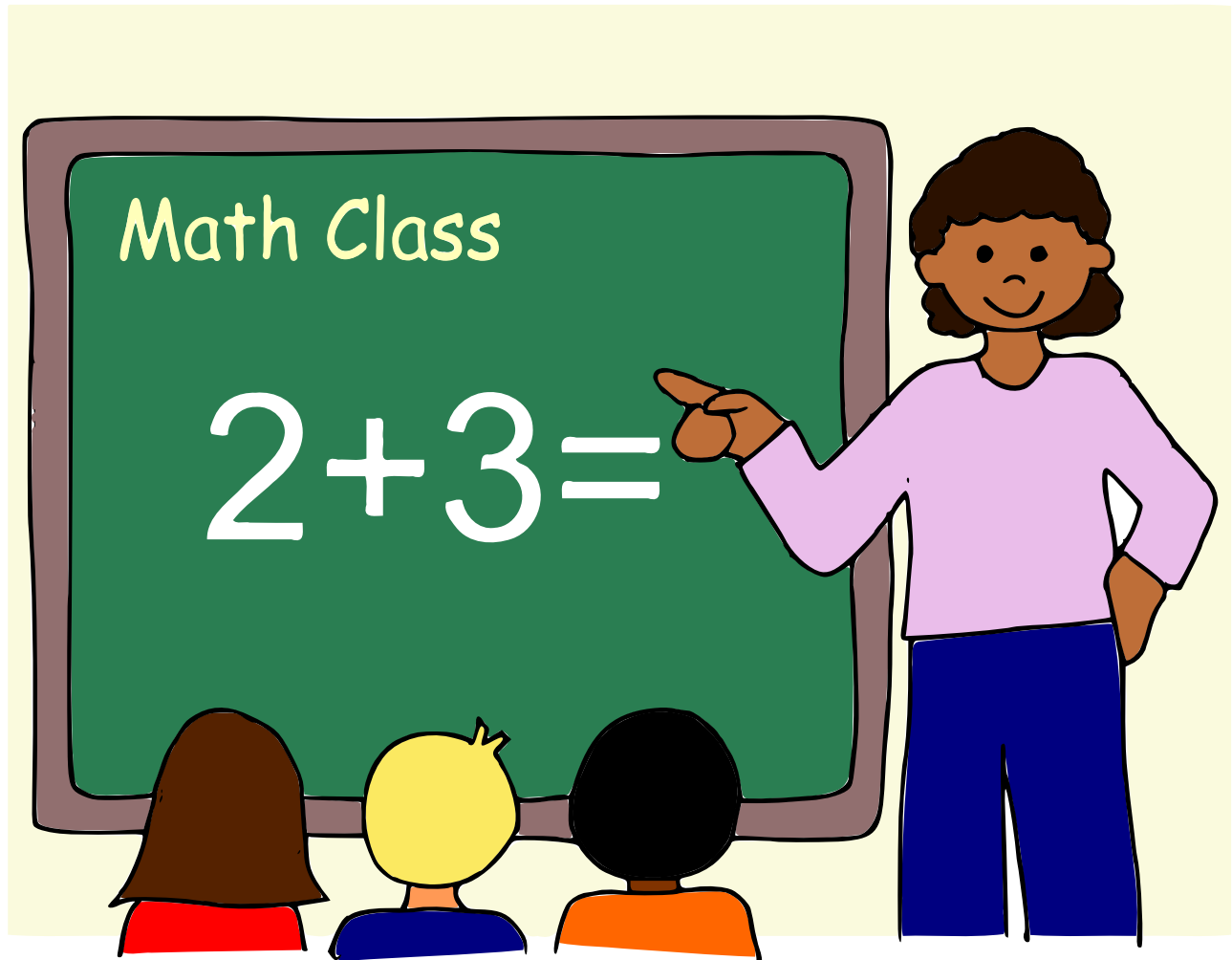
I have jobs to do at school also.

Sometimes my teacher teaches small groups while others work.



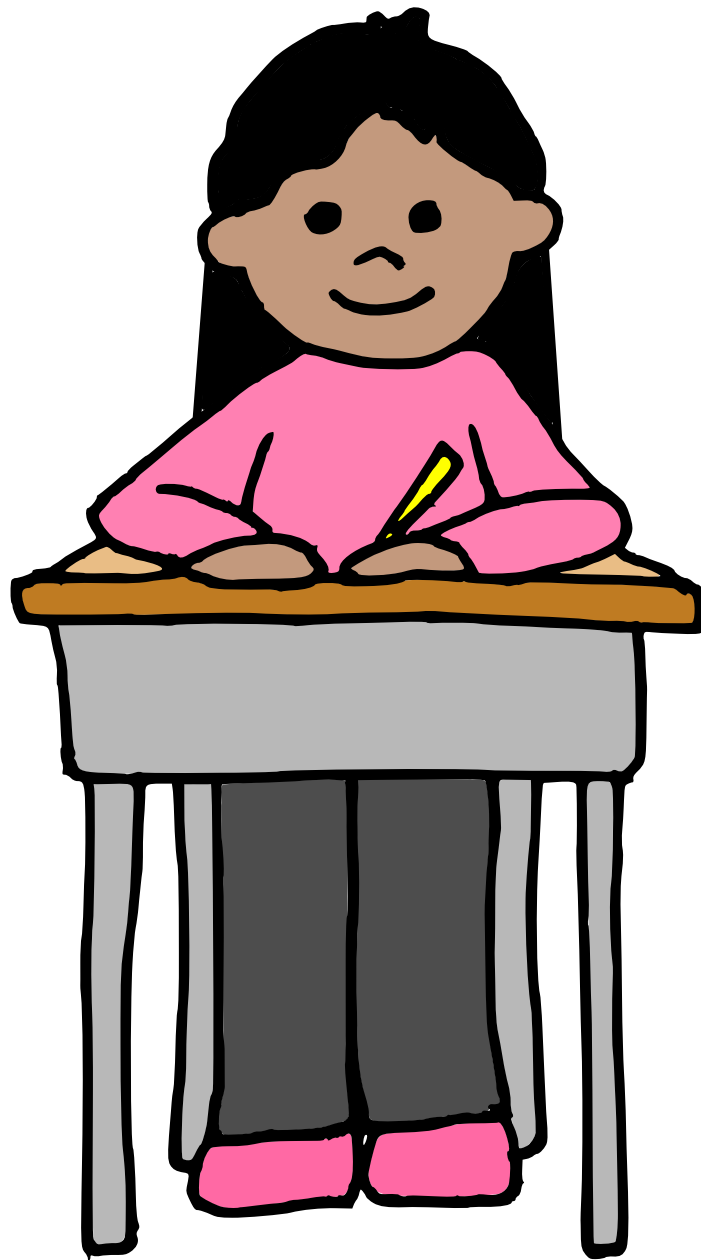
Sometimes my teacher teaches at the front of the class to all the students.



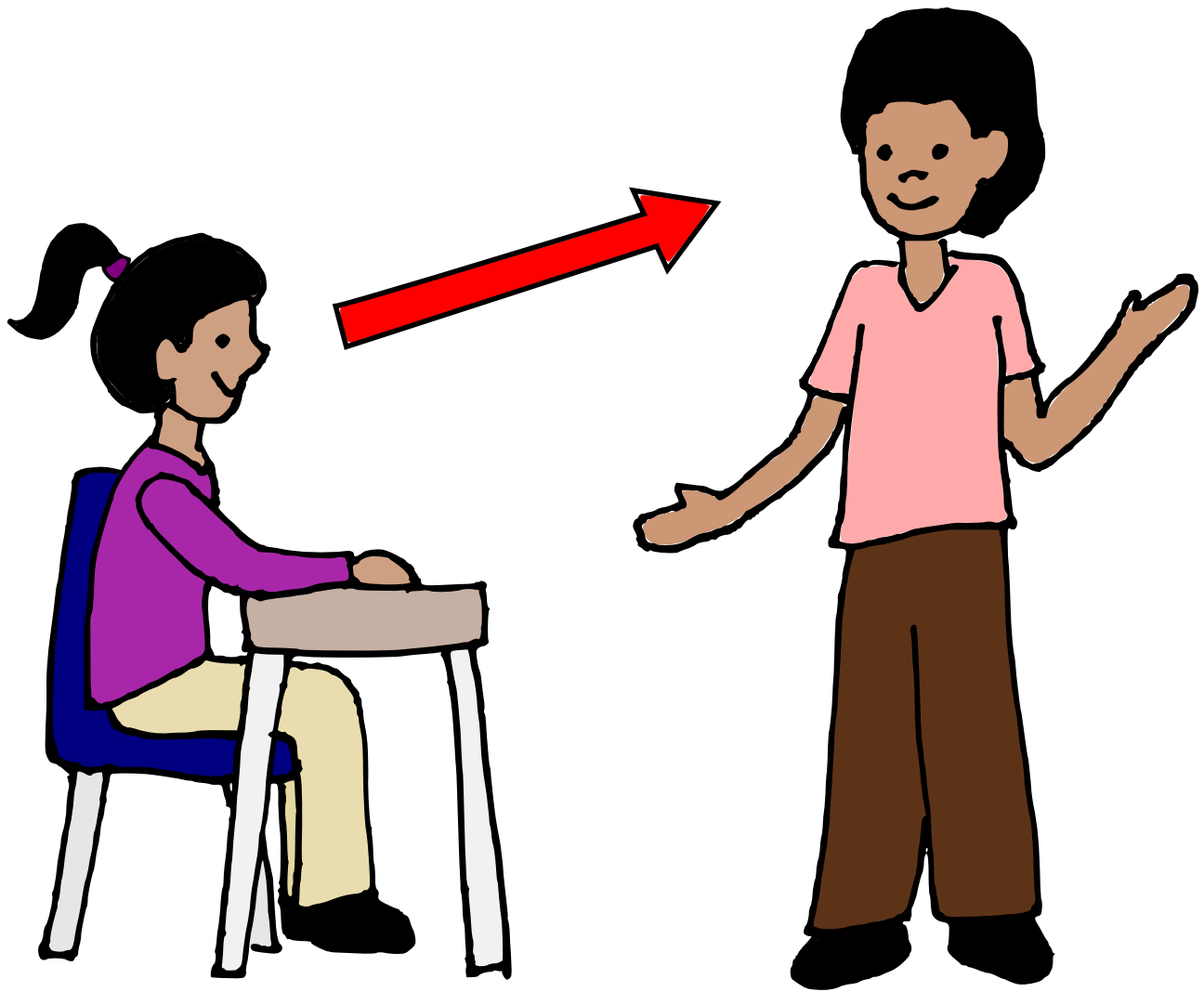
Sometimes a teacher works just with
me.



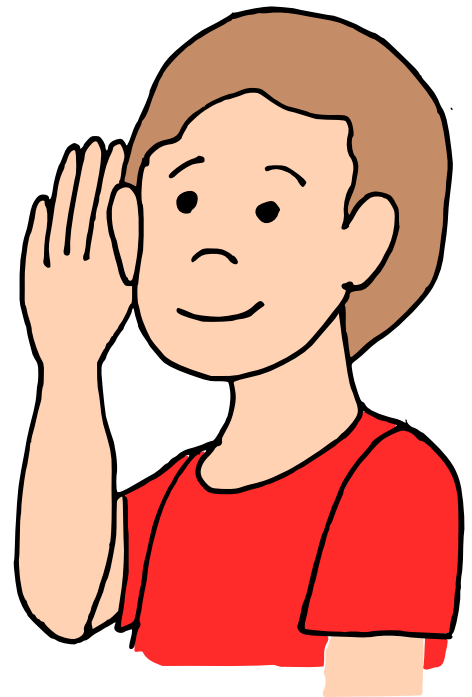
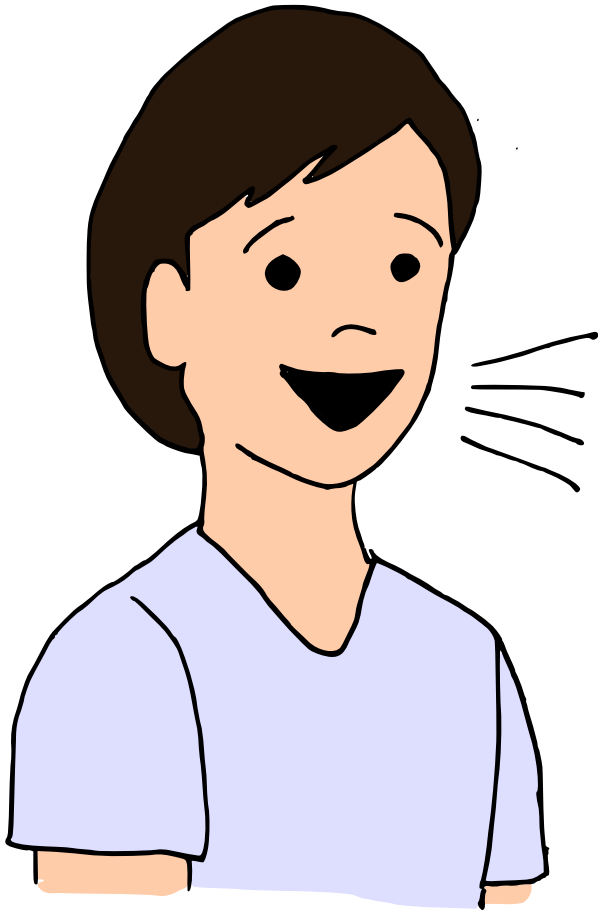
The students' job is to listen and watch the teacher. Students raise their hand to answer questions or make comments.

tells me to sit.



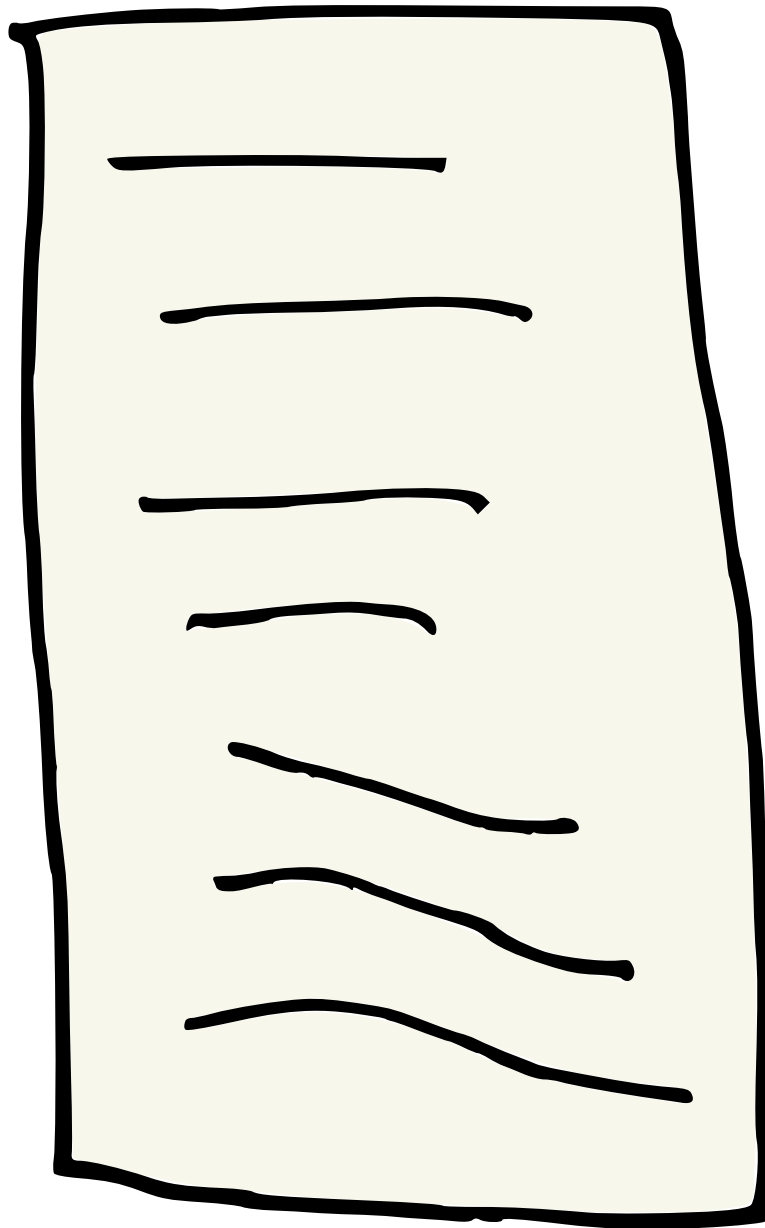
My job is to look toward the teacher
when she is talking.



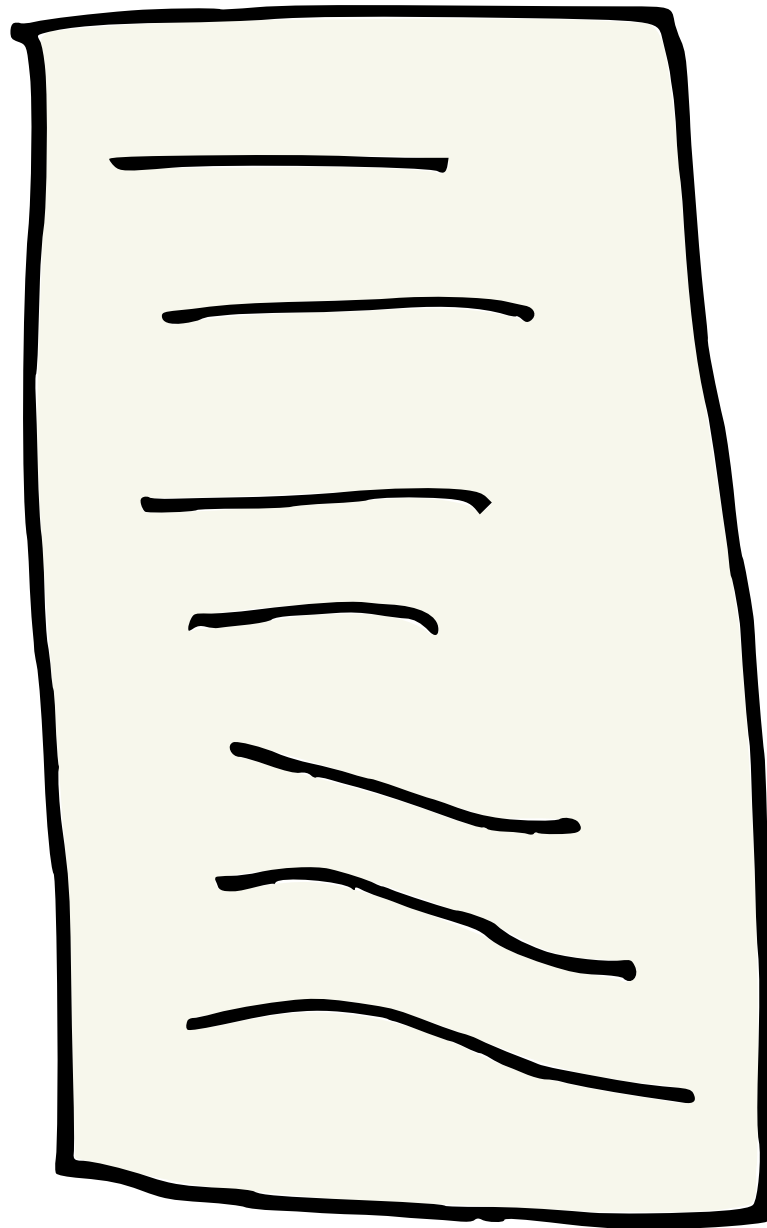
My job is to listen to the teacher
