GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

❖ STUDENTS NEED A MINIMUM OF 80 CREDITS (20 COURSES) IN GRADES 10 TO 12 TO GRADUATE

❖ 12 REQUIRED COURSES

❖ COUNSELLORS WILL BE REVIEWING ALL OF OUR GRADE 12 TRANSCRIPTS THROUGHOUT OCTOBER TO ENSURE THAT GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS WILL BE MET BY JUNE 2024

❖ COUNSELLORS WILL CONNECT WITH THOSE STUDENTS & THEIR FAMILIES WHO ARE IN *JEOPARDY* OF NOT GRADUATING FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

PRINCIPAL'S LIST & HONOUR ROLL – IN GRADE 12



❖ IN GRADE 12, STUDENTS MUST HAVE A **FULL TIMETABLE** (8 COURSES) TO QUALIFY FOR PRINCIPAL'S HONOUR ROLL, HONOUR ROLL WITH DISTINCTION, HONOUR ROLL AND HONOURS CORD

✓ 80 HOUR WORK EXPERIENCE DOES COUNT AS A COURSE IN GRADE 12

❖ GPA CALCULATION IS BASED ON **ALL** OF YOUR COURSES

✓ **PRINCIPAL'S HONOUR ROLL** → 4.0

✓ **HONOUR ROLL WITH DISTINCTION** → 3.5 TO 3.99

✓ **HONOUR ROLL** → 3.0 TO 3.49

❖ **HONOUR CORD** → STUDENTS ON THE **PRINCIPAL'S HONOUR ROLL** OR **HONOUR ROLL WITH DISTINCTION** EVERY TERM IN GRADE 11 & TERM 1 & 2 OF GRADE 12

- ❖ IF YOU'RE UNDECIDED ABOUT WHAT YOU WANT TO DO AFTER HIGH SCHOOL, IT'S IMPORTANT THAT YOU RESEARCH WHAT YOUR BEST OPTIONS ARE
 - ❖ ARE YOU PLANNING ON GOING TO SCHOOL (COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY)?
 - ❖ ARE YOU PLANNING ON GETTING A PART-TIME JOB?
 - ❖ ARE YOU PLANNING ON DOING SOME TRAVELLING BEFORE YOU START SCHOOL?
- ❖ NOW IS THE TIME TO MAKE A PLAN WHILE YOU HAVE THE SUPPORT OF YOUR TEACHERS, COUNSELLORS & PARENTS

- ❖ *LOOK AT OPTIONS HERE IN THE LOWER MAINLAND IF YOU CAN LIVE AT HOME*

- ❖ *CONSIDER SCHOOLS IN CITIES WHERE YOU HAVE EXTENDED FAMILY*

- ❖ *LOOK AT SCHOOLS WITH PROGRAMS THAT INTEREST YOU*

3. HOW LONG DO YOU WANT TO GO TO SCHOOL FOR?

- ❖ *DO YOU WANT TO COMPLETE A CERTIFICATE? (1 YR) A DIPLOMA? (2 YRS) A BACHELORS (4 YRS) A MASTERS? (ADDITIONAL 2-5 YEARS) A PHD? (ADDITIONAL YEARS ON TOP OF A MASTERS)*

- ❖ *LOOK AT COLLEGES, UNIVERSITIES AND TECHNICAL INSTITUTIONS AS EACH OFFER DIFFERENT PROGRAMS, DEGREES, ETC..*

6. WHAT DO YOU NEED TO GET INTO YOUR SCHOOL OF CHOICE?

- ❖ YOU NEED TO DO YOUR RESEARCH AS EVERY SCHOOL IS DIFFERENT, EVEN FOR THE EXACT SAME PROGRAM
- ❖ LOOK ONLINE, ATTEND POST-SECONDARY INFO SESSIONS (IN PERSON & VIRTUAL)

7. WHEN DO YOU NEED TO APPLY?

- ❖ YOU NEED TO CHECK ONLINE FOR DEADLINES AS EACH INSTITUTION IS DIFFERENT
- ❖ MANY COLLEGES ARE FIRST-COME-FIRST-SERVE SO APPLY ASAP
- ❖ MOST BC COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES YOU APPLY THROUGH WWW.APPLYBC.CA
- ❖ SOME POST-SECONDARY SCHOOLS YOU NEED TO APPLY DIRECTLY THROUGH THEIR WEBSITE (IE: BCIT)

8. HOW DO YOU KNOW IF YOU'RE ACCEPTED?

- ❖ SCHOOLS OFTEN CONTACT YOU THROUGH ONLY YOUR EMAIL – CHECK IT REGULARLY!! EVEN YOUR JUNK FOLDER → DO....NOT.....MISS....THESE....MESSAGES
- ❖ YOU CAN ALSO LOGIN TO EACH SCHOOL YOU APPLIED TO WITH THE STUDENT ID THAT THEY GAVE YOU TO CHECK YOUR “APPLICATION STATUS”

SO YOU'RE PLANNING TO GO TO SCHOOL

9. WHAT ELSE DO YOU HAVE TO DO?

- ❖ AFTER YOU APPLY ONLINE TO YOUR POST-SECONDARY CHOICES YOU WILL NEED TO APPLY FOR HOUSING IF YOU'RE MOVING CLOSER TO YOUR SCHOOL
- ❖ APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS – BOTH DIRECTLY TO THE COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY AND EXTERNAL SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS
- ❖ VISIT CAMPUSES IF YOU CAN TO HELP YOU MAKE A FINAL DECISION OF WHAT SCHOOL TO GO TO

10. HOW DO YOU FINALIZE YOUR APPLICATION?

- ❖ FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS OF EACH POST-SECONDARY FOR HOW YOU WILL SELF-REPORT YOUR GRADES TO THEM – EACH ONE HAS THEIR OWN EXACT WAY THEY WANT IT, SO YOU MUST FOLLOW THEIR INSTRUCTIONS

11. HOW DO YOU CHOOSE YOUR POST-SECONDARY CLASSES?

- ❖ MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH AN ADVISOR AT YOUR POST-SECONDARY SCHOOL
- ❖ YOUR SCHOOL COUNSELLOR CAN OFFER ADVICE, BUT WE DO NOT KNOW WHAT COURSES YOU ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE IN YOUR 1ST YEAR AT YOUR CHOSEN COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY

12. WHAT ABOUT ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS?

- ❖ *CONNECT WITH OUR ATHLETIC DIRECTOR (MR. PUNI) AS HE MAY KNOW OF SOME SCHOLARSHIPS OUT THERE*
- ❖ *CONNECT WITH THE COACH OF YOUR SPORT TO FIND OUT ABOUT TRYOUTS AT YOUR POST-SECONDARY SCHOOL*
 - ❖ *ALSO ASK THEM ABOUT ANY FINANCIAL AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE*

13. WANTING TO APPLY TO SCHOOL IN ANOTHER COUNTRY?

- ❖ *YOU WILL NEED TO DO YOUR RESEARCH AS TO WHAT THOSE SCHOOLS REQUIRE*

14. DO YOU WANT TO COMBINE SCHOOL WITH TRAVEL?

- ❖ *SOME POST-SECONDARY SCHOOLS OFFER OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOU TO LIVE IN ANOTHER COUNTRY BUT PAY CANADIAN TUITION – YOU WILL HAVE TO APPLY FOR THIS, AND IT IS OFTEN IN 2ND OR 3RD YEAR OF YOUR BACHELOR'S DEGREE – YOU STILL HAVE TO PAY FOR YOUR FLIGHT AND LIVING EXPENSES THOUGH*
- ❖ *ONCE YOU'RE IN YOUR POST-SECONDARY, YOU CAN ASK ADVISORS THERE ABOUT OPTIONS*

POST-SECONDARY OPTIONS

❖ 3 DIFFERENT TYPES OF POST-SECONDARY SCHOOLS AVAILABLE:

1) UNIVERSITIES

a) TRADITIONAL “RESEARCH” UNIVERSITIES

- KNOWN AS “RESEARCH INTENSIVE”
- OFFER: PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMS, UNDERGRADUATE DEGREES, GRADUATE DEGREES
- IE: UBC, SFU, UVIC, UNBC, UOFT, MCGILL, WATERLOO, ETC...

b) “TEACHING INTENSIVE” UNIVERSITIES

- UPGRADING OPPORTUNITIES, UNIVERSITY TRANSFER, TRADES, SPECIALITY PROGRAMS
- OFFER: CERTIFICATES, DIPLOMAS, SOME UNDERGRADUATE & GRADUATE DEGREES
- IE: CAPILANO UNIVERSITY, KWANTLEN POLYTECHNIC, THOMPSON RIVERS, UFV, VIU

c) “SPECIALTY” UNIVERSITIES

- SPECIALTY “NICHE” PROGRAMS
- OFFER: BACHELOR’S DEGREES AND MASTERS DEGREES
- IE: EMILY CARR UNIVERSITY OF ART & DESIGN, ROYAL ROADS UNIVERSITY

POST-SECONDARY OPTIONS

❖ 3 DIFFERENT TYPES OF POST-SECONDARY SCHOOLS AVAILABLE:

2) COLLEGES

- SAME AS UNIVERSITY IN: COURSES, CREDITS & CREDENTIALS
- DIFFERENT AS UNIVERSITY IN: CLASS SIZE, COST & ADMISSIONS
- OFFER: BACHELOR'S DEGREES, CERTIFICATES, DIPLOMAS, TRADES, UPGRADING, UNIVERSITY TRANSFER
- IE: DOUGLAS, LANGARA, VCC

3) INSTITUTIONS

- FOCUS MORE ON THE TECHNICAL & TRADES
- OFFER: BACHELORS DEGREES, CERTIFICATES, DIPLOMAS, MASTERS DEGREES
- IE: BCIT, JUSTICE INSTITUTE OF BC, NICOLA VALLEY INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

HOW DO STUDENTS APPLY TO POST-SECONDARY??

❖ ALL STUDENTS NEED TO APPLY FOR THE MAJORITY OF THE BC COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES ONLINE THROUGH THE EDUCATION PLANNER BC WEBSITE - WWW.EDUCATIONPLANNERBC.CA


❖ STUDENTS WILL HAVE TO:



1. REGISTER FOR AN ACCOUNT ONLINE
2. COMPLETE AN EDUCATIONAL PROFILE
3. CHOOSE WHAT COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES THEY WANT TO APPLY TO
4. CHOOSE WHAT SPECIFIC PROGRAM OF STUDY THEY WANT TO APPLY TO (*IE: ARTS, BUSINESS, SCIENCE, APPLIED SCIENCE: ENGINEERING, ETC...*)
5. PROVIDE ADDITIONAL INSTITUTION-SPECIFIC INFORMATION
6. PAY APPLICATION FEES

HOW DO COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES GET ALL OF MY MARKS??

- ❖ **STUDENT TRANSCRIPT SERVICE (STS)** IS HOW STUDENTS WILL ORDER ELECTRONIC TRANSCRIPTS AND SEND THEM TO THEIR POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTIONS IN BC
 - ❖ *ALL STUDENTS GET 25 FREE TRANSCRIPTS - IF THEY WANT MORE THEN EACH ADDITIONAL IS \$10*
- ❖ **BUT!!** THEY **MUST** REGISTER FOR A BC GOVERNMENT ACCOUNT (BCEID) **BEFORE** ACCESSING THE **STS (STUDENT TRANSCRIPT SERVICE)**
 - ❖ **THIS IS DIFFERENT THAN THE EDUCATION PLANNER BC ACCOUNT THAT YOU HAD TO SIGN UP FOR**
- ❖ TO REGISTER THEY WILL NEED:
 - ❖ *THEIR PEN (PERSONAL EDUCATION NUMBER) – HINT, IT'S ON YOUR REPORT CARD*
 - ❖ *LEGAL FIRST & LAST NAME*
 - ❖ *BIRTHDATE*
 - ❖ *EMAIL*
- ❖ THEY MUST FOLLOW THEIR STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS
- ❖ ONCE FINISH REGISTERING, A CONFIRMATION EMAIL WILL BE SENT FOR THEM TO ACTIVATE THEIR ACCOUNT
- ❖ THE LINK WILL PROMPT THEM TO ENTER THEIR BCEID USER NAME & PASSWORD TO FINALIZE THE PROCESS

BC COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS

❖ MOST BC COLLEGE ACCEPTANCE IS ON A **FIRST COME FIRST SERVED** BASIS, SO APPLY ONLINE **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE** TO SECURE YOUR SPOT

❖ MANY COLLEGES OPEN APPLICATIONS AFTER OCTOBER 1ST

❖ SOME COLLEGE PROGRAM ACCEPTANCE IS BASED ON BASIC GRADUATION

❖ CERTAIN PROGRAMS DO HAVE COURSE REQUIREMENTS

❖ IE: MINIMUM MARK IN ENGLISH 12

❖ COLLEGE ALSO OFFERS UPGRADING OPPORTUNITIES

❖ IE: CAN TAKE GRADE 12 COURSES



UNIVERSITY ADMISSIONS IN BC

❖ ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR BC UNIVERSITIES (EX: UBC & SFU) HAVE CHANGED

❖ BEFORE

- ❖ ADMISSION WAS BASED ON ENGLISH 12 + 3 ACADEMIC GRADE 12 COURSES
(*DEPENDING ON THE FAULTY THAT YOU WERE APPLYING TO*)
- ❖ UNIVERSITIES REALIZED THAT THIS WAS A VERY SMALL SNAPSHOT OF A STUDENT'S PERFORMANCE IN SCHOOL AND THEIR ACTUAL ABILITIES

❖ NOW

- ❖ STUDENT PERFORMANCE IS VIEWED FROM A BROADER PERSPECTIVE
- ❖ NO LONGER JUST 4 GRADE 12 COURSES
- ❖ ADMISSIONS ARE NOW TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION ALL OF YOUR ACADEMIC GRADE 11 AND 12 COURSES
- ❖ THEY WANT TO SEE HOW YOU HAVE PERFORMED IN YOUR CLASSES IN YOUR SENIOR YEARS OF SCHOOL

UBC ADMISSION UPDATES

❖ UBC HAS CHANGED OVER THE YEARS HOW THEY EVALUATE APPLICATIONS

❖ NO MATTER WHAT FACULTY YOU ARE APPLYING TO, UBC WILL NOW BROADLY EVALUATE YOUR ACADEMIC HISTORY BY LOOKING AT **ALL** ACADEMIC GRADE 11 **AND** GRADE 12 COURSES

❖ APPLICANTS ARE RECOMMENDED TO HAVE **6 APPROVED** ACADEMIC COURSES

❖ UBC WILL **EXCLUDE** THE COURSE THAT HAS YOUR LOWEST GRADE

❖ **NOTE:** AS LONG AS THE COURSE IS NOT A DEGREE-SPECIFIC REQUIREMENT OR RELEVANT TO YOUR INTENDED AREA OF STUDY AT UBC

❖ UBC WILL ALSO LOOK AT INDIVIDUAL GRADES IN **KEY COURSES** - YOU MUST HAVE STRONG GRADES IN THESE (IE: ENGLISH 12 OR PRE-CALCULUS 12 DEPENDING ON FACULTY)

❖ EACH FACULTY WILL ALSO HAVE DEGREE-SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

❖ CHECK UBC WEBSITE FOR INFORMATION ON INDIVIDUAL REQUIREMENTS)

❖ THE APPLICATION STILL INCLUDES THE **UBC PERSONAL PROFILE**



UBC ADMISSION UPDATES & LITERACY 12 ASSESSMENT

❖ UBC HAS, AS OF OCTOBER 2022, ANNOUNCED THEIR POSITION ON THE LITERACY 12 ASSESSMENTS

❖ UBC HAS STATED THAT THEY WILL TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION THE LITERACY 12 ASSESSMENT

❖ HERE ARE THE DETAILS:

1. LITERACY 12 ASSESSMENT MARK WILL NOT BE REQUIRED AT TIME OF YOUR APPLICATION
 - IE: YOU WON'T HAVE TO HAVE YOUR FINAL MARK WHEN YOU SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION IN DECEMBER/JANUARY
2. STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE THE LITERACY 12 ASSESSMENT TO MAINTAIN THEIR OFFER OF ADMISSION
3. STUDENTS MUST RECEIVE A "PROFICIENT" LEVEL ON THE EXAM IN ORDER TO KEEP YOUR OFFER OF ADMISSION
 - THIS MEANS AT LEAST A "3" ON THE EXAM (THE EXAM IS OUT OF "4")
4. THOSE STUDENTS WHO DON'T RECEIVE A "PROFICIENT" LEVEL (SO LEVEL 3 OR 4) WILL BE ASSESSED ON A "CASE BY CASE" BASIS
 - UBC HAS NOT GIVEN US ANY DETAILS ON HOW THIS "CASE BY CASE BASIS" LOOKS



UBC PERSONAL PROFILE



- ❖ UBC PERSONAL PROFILE IS A VERY IMPORTANT PART OF THE UBC APPLICATION
- ❖ THE PERSONAL PROFILE HELPS UBC ASSESS IF STUDENTS ARE PREPARED FOR UNIVERSITY + IF THEY'LL RECEIVE AN ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP
- ❖ IT ALSO GIVES **STUDENTS** A CHANCE TO TELL UBC ABOUT WHAT'S IMPORTANT TO **THEM**:
 - ❖ *WHAT ARE YOUR SIGNIFICANT ACHIEVEMENTS?*
 - ❖ *WHAT HAVE YOU LEARNED FROM YOUR EXPERIENCES?*
 - ❖ *WHAT CHALLENGES HAVE YOU OVERCOME IN YOUR LIFE?*
- ❖ EACH QUESTION REQUIRES SHORT ESSAY ANSWERS (50-200 WORDS)
 - ❖ **NOT** ABOUT SIMPLY LISTING ACTIVITIES/EXPERIENCES, BUT ABOUT BEING ABLE TO EXPLAIN WHAT YOU'VE LEARNED FROM YOUR EXPERIENCES
- ❖ **SAMPLE QUESTION:** *"EXPLAIN HOW YOU HAVE RESPONDED TO A SIGNIFICANT CHALLENGE THAT YOU HAVE ENCOUNTERED, AND WHAT YOU LEARNED IN THE PROCESS"*

UBC PERSONAL PROFILE



- ❖ UBC'S TRAINED READERS WILL READ AND EVALUATE YOUR PERSONAL PROFILE AND COMPARE IT WITH THE PROFILES WRITTEN BY OTHER UBC APPLICANTS
- ❖ YOUR PROFILE WILL BE ASSESSED AGAINST FOUR CRITERIA:
 1. **ENGAGEMENT & ACCOMPLISHMENT**
 2. **LEADERSHIP**
 3. **SUBSTANCE**
 4. **VOICE**

SFU ADMISSIONS UPDATES



- ❖ SFU HAS CHANGED HOW THEY WILL BE EVALUATING YOUR APPLICATION
 - ❖ SFU HAS STATED THAT **ALL “APPROVED” COURSES MATTER**
 - ❖ ALL APPROVED GRADE 11 **AND** GRADE 12 COURSES WILL BE USED IN THE EVALUATION
 - ❖ **WE ARE COMPREHENSIVELY EVALUATING YOUR HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT**
 - ❖ APPLICANTS MUST PRESENT A MINIMUM OF **5 APPROVED** GRADE 12 COURSES (INCLUDING ENGLISH STUDIES 12 OR ENGLISH FIRST PEOPLES 12)
 - ❖ EACH FACULTY WILL PROVIDE 2 LISTS (“LIST A” & “LIST B”) WHICH WILL LIST THE SPECIFIC COURSES REQUIRED FOR THEIR FACULTY
 - ❖ *CHECK SFU WEBSITE FOR INFORMATION ON INDIVIDUAL REQUIREMENTS*

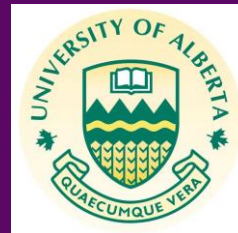

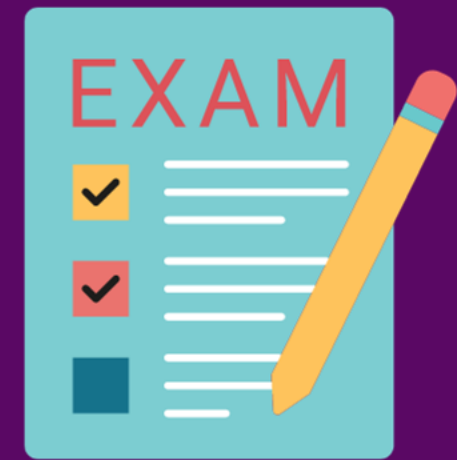

COLLEGE TO UNIVERSITY TRANSFER



- ❖ UNIVERSITY TRANSFER MEANS YOU START STUDYING AT COLLEGE, THEN **TRANSFER** TO UNIVERSITY TO COMPLETE YOUR STUDIES
- ❖ UNIVERSITY WILL RECOGNIZE THE EDUCATION YOU TOOK AT COLLEGE
 - ❖ IE: 2 YEARS AT COLLEGE + 2 YEARS AT UNIVERSITY = BACHELOR'S DEGREE FROM UNIVERSITY
- ❖ ADVANTAGES:
 - ❖ LOWER TOTAL COST FOR YOUR DEGREE
 - ❖ SMALLER CLASS SIZES
 - ❖ UNIVERSITIES LIKE COLLEGE TRANSFER STUDENTS



❖ CHALLENGES:

- ❖ REQUIRES MORE PLANNING – YOU NEED TO ENSURE YOUR COURSES WILL TRANSFER TO UNIVERSITY

DIFFERENCES BETWEEN HIGH SCHOOL & POST-SECONDARY

I. ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT

- ❖ LARGER NUMBER OF STUDENTS IN CLASSES
- ❖ CLASSES MEET LESS → 1-2 TIMES PER WEEK

II. GRADING

- ❖ AN A & B REQUIRE HIGHER QUALITY OF WORK
- ❖ STUDY HABITS NEED TO IMPROVE TO MAINTAIN MARKS YOU WERE ABLE TO ACHIEVE IN HS
- ❖ MINIMUM EFFORT OF WORK IS OFTEN FAILED

III. KNOWLEDGE ACQUISITION

- ❖ TAKE GOOD NOTES IN LECTURES & LABS
- ❖ READING & ASSIGNMENTS ARE JUST AS IMPORTANT AS WHAT IS COVERED IN LECTURES FROM PROFS
- ❖ EXPECT 2-3 HOURS OF STUDYING FOR EACH CLASS EACH NIGHT
- ❖ YOU WILL SPEND MUCH MORE TIME DOING READINGS ON YOUR OWN AT HOME AFTER CLASSES ARE OVER



IV. STUDENT SUPPORTS

- ❖ LESS CONTACT WITH PROFESSORS THAN TEACHERS
- ❖ PROFESSORS DON'T PROVIDE MUCH INDIVIDUAL FEEDBACK
- ❖ STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO TAKE INITIATIVE TO ASK QUESTIONS IN CLASS OR CONTACT PROFESSORS

V. STRESS

- ❖ 4-5 COURSES ARE COMPLETED IN 14 WEEKS
- ❖ PACE IS VERY FAST AND WORKLOAD CAN BE HEAVY
- ❖ FEW / NO REMINDERS ABOUT DUE DATES

VI. RESPONSIBILITY

- ❖ YOU NEED TO BE VERY INDEPENDENT ABOUT READING & STUDYING
- ❖ TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF
 - ❖ GET ENOUGH SLEEP, EXERCISE, EAT WELL & KNOW WHEN YOU NEED HELP AND HOW TO GET IT

 - ❖ *IE: FROM TEACHERS, COACHES, CURRENT JOB MANAGERS*

❖ GET ANY CERTIFICATES YOU MAY NEED

- ❖ *IE: FOOD SAFE, FIRST AID, DRIVERS LICENSE, SUPERHOST*

❖ FIND & APPLY FOR A JOB

- ❖ *IE: ONLINE (ZIP RECRUITER, INDEED), PERSONAL CONTACTS*

❖ BE PREPARED TO WORK IN AN ENTRY LEVEL POSITION

- ❖ AS YOU'RE JUST LEAVING HIGH SCHOOL, MANY JOBS AVAILABLE MAY BE ENTRY LEVEL – BUT BE OPEN TO OPTIONS AS YOU NEVER KNOW WHAT MAY SPARK AN INTEREST IN YOU

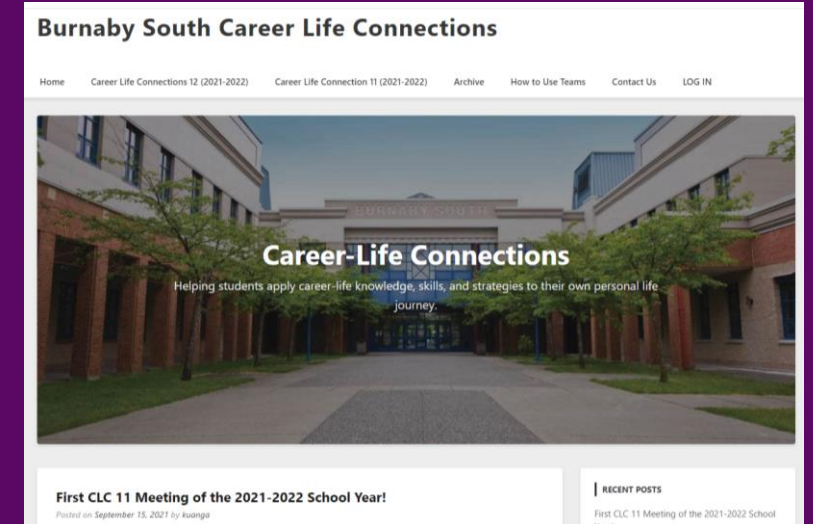

- ❖ SO.....HOW MUCH WILL 1 YEAR OF POST-SECONDARY APPROXIMATELY COST?
 - ✓ BC UNIVERSITIES (TUITION & STUDENT FEES) → \$8200
 - ✓ BC COLLEGES (TUITION & STUDENT FEES) → \$5800
 - ✓ BOOKS & SUPPLIES → \$150/COURSE – SO A FULL TIME STUDENT CAN EXPECT TO PAY APPROX. \$1500 PER 2 SEMESTERS ← THIS IS ON TOP OF YOUR TUITION
 - ✓ ROOM & BOARD (RESIDENCE & FOOD) → \$12,000 TO \$15,000
 - ✓ PERSONAL COSTS (IE; CLOTHING, SPENDING \$\$, GAS) → \$7000
 - ✓ COLLEGE 1 YEAR TOTAL: \$12,000 OR \$27,000 IF IN RESIDENCE

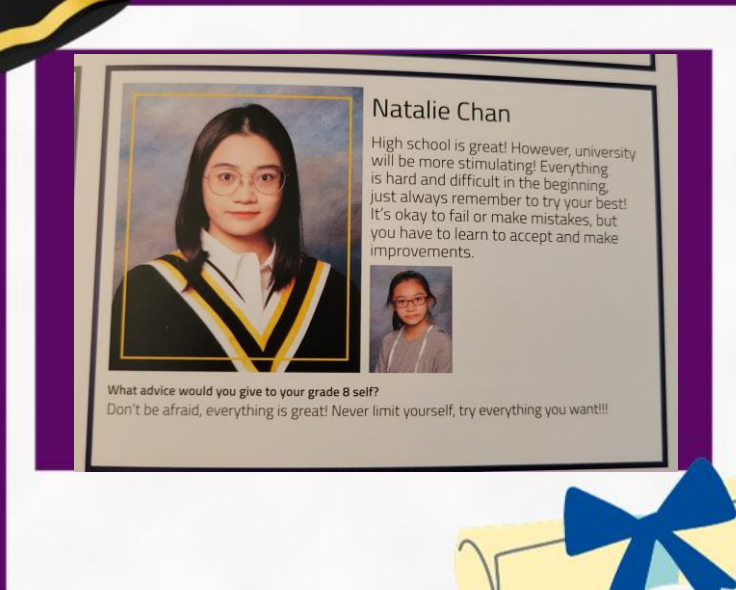

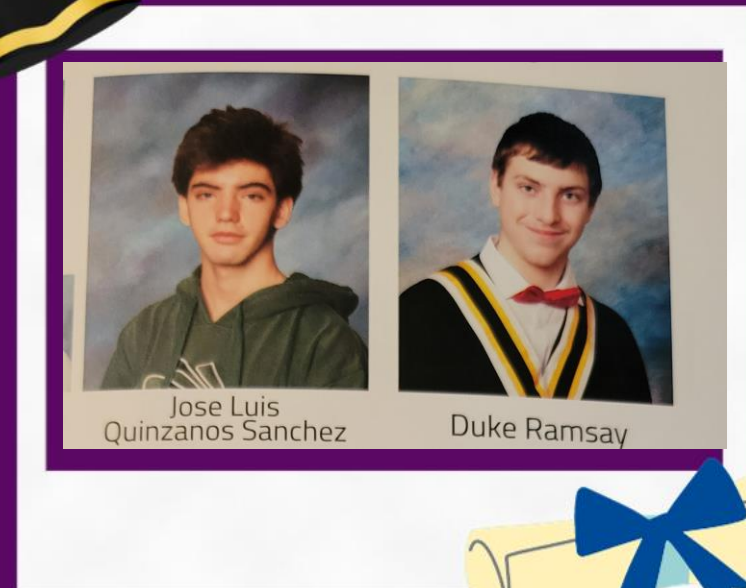

- ✓ MAKE SURE TO GIVE THEM AT LEAST 3 WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF THE DUE DATE
- ✓ ALWAYS GIVE YOUR REFERENCES A COPY OF YOUR:
 - 1) **HIGH SCHOOL ACCOMPLISHMENT RESUME**
 - 2) **STUDENT BRAG SHEET**
 - 3) **LETTER OF REFERENCE REQUEST FORM (FOR COUNSELLORS & TEACHERS)**
