## **CLC 12 – Graduation Project Presentation Checklist**

Sign up for Q3 or Q4 presentation date outside Student Services.  Q3: April 6 to 9
<ul> <li>Q4: May 17 to 28</li> </ul>
Choose a presentation method. See slides for examples.
Prepare your presentation:  Think about: organization, creativity, use of visuals.  Presentation is no more than 10 minutes long (between 8 – 10 minutes).
Prepare a script for your presentation and rehearse (should be note/cue card free).  Need to include:  Discussion about your initial project goal, the process, and the end result  Share at least 4 artifacts/evidence of what you did throughout the project  Makes strong connections between personal growth and the Graduation Project journey  Reflect on challenges, successes and new learnings  Reflect on personal, post-graduation and/or career goals
<ul> <li>Prepare your Portfolio to be handed in <u>on the day of your presentation</u>.</li> <li>Need to include: <ol> <li>Printed hard copy and stapled together</li> <li>Title page: Project title, first and last name, and student number</li> <li>Up-to-date Grad Project Plan</li> <li>Log sheets (Q1, Q2, Q3 &amp; Q4 – Q4 not applicable if presenting in Q3) with parent/guardian signatures</li> <li>Detailed list of your resources (websites/forums, videos, books, mentorship) **should include at least one resource from each category to obtain full marks</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
Review presentation marking rubric to ensure you have met all the criteria.
You will be provided a PC laptop and projector. Bring with you any other technology/adaptor/USB to make you presentation a success.
Prepare a business casual outfit for the presentation.
Get a good night's rest.
Arrive to the presentation room (MPR) 10 mins early.  A-L (eastside entrance)  M-Z (westside entrance)
