# What is the CLC Graduation Project?

(AKA  
Capstone)

- The CLC Graduation Project is the culminating project for CLC 12.
- **YOUR GOAL** is to explore a topic in a career area of interest or a passion. Through this topic you will develop a project that will allow you to develop a skillset.
- The project should be something you value, care about, or find interest in. Only then will it be meaningful and purposeful.





# Why are we doing this project?

- In addition to it being a graduation requirement, the Grad Project is a celebration of learning and experience.
- This project is designed to encourage you to think critically, solve problems and develop existing or new skills.
- It will allow you to connect with the world outside of school and to demonstrate that you have the skills to go on to further your education and enter the workforce.
- Furthermore, it's a good project to add to your portfolio.

# The project consists of 4 components:





- June 2020: you should have already drafted a proposal for your project idea.
- You plan should focus on developing a skill/skillset in a career area or a passion.
- **Now:** You will need to submit a **FINAL PLAN by Oct 30** through Teams.

# FINAL GRAD PROJECT PLAN



- After submitting your plan, you will start working on your project.
  - ➔ Watch out for project feedback from Mr. Kwan/Ms.Kuang in Teams.

- We recommend that you **dedicate a minimum of 20 hours** towards the project (max. 30 hours).
- To track these hours, you will submit **a quarterly log sheet**.

# QUARTERLY LOG SHEET TEMPLATE



- The portfolio is a collection of all the documentation for your project that will be collected through Teams.
- This includes: your Final Grad Project Plan, quarterly logs, and a detailed list of your resources.

## How to Select a Grad Project?

**Step 1:** Choose a career area or passion you are interested in exploring.

**Step 2:** Choose a specific topic within that career or passion.

**Step 3:** Identify a skill/skill set that you want to expand on within the topic you have selected.

**Step 4:** Choose a project style to carry out your project.

# There are 5 Project Styles (not limited to):

Project

Event

Entrepreneurial

Service

Research

# There are 5 Project Styles (not limited to):

- A. Project** – Focus is to develop, design and build a model of a tangible object
- B. Event** – Research, create and host an event
- C. Entrepreneurship** – Prepare a business plan. This project will allow you to experience start of a new business.
- D. Service** – Research an issue in your community, develop and implement a solution.
- E. Research** – Academic research or experiment to develop new arguments or insights

# There are 5 Project Styles (not limited to):

- You are not limited to the 5 project styles, if there is some other format/style in which you like to carryout your project, speak with Mr. Kwan/Ms. Kuang 😊
- Please read the **Grad Project Student Guide** for more info about the 5 different project styles and step-by-step instructions of how to carry out each project style.

## Resources

- As part of your CLC Graduation Project, you will be asked to submit a detailed list of resources that you used to help you with your project.
- **Includes: Websites/blogs/forums, videos, books, mentorship**
- To score full credits for the resource section, all four types of resources must be used.

# Resources

## Mentorship

- The length of time you spend with your mentor is up to you and dependent on your individual needs.
- How the mentorship looks will vary from person to person.
- E.g. some may meet once for resources/interview, others may meet monthly for project feedback.



## Choosing A Mentor

- Check Teams for document about how to find a suitable mentor.
- Mentor should be an adult with knowledge of your topic.
- Qualities to look for:
  - Similar values
  - Open communication
  - Willingness to help
  - Agreed upon expectations



## What does a good Graduation Project look like?

### A good Graduation Project:

- ✓ Reflects your personal interest in a certain career area or passion.
- ✓ Shows your process.
- ✓ Clearly communicates new learning.
- ✓ Evolves over a period of time and is not rushed.
- ✓ Clearly shows the amount of time and consideration you have put in to completing it.
- ✓ Shows the depth of your investigation i.e. using a variety of resources.
