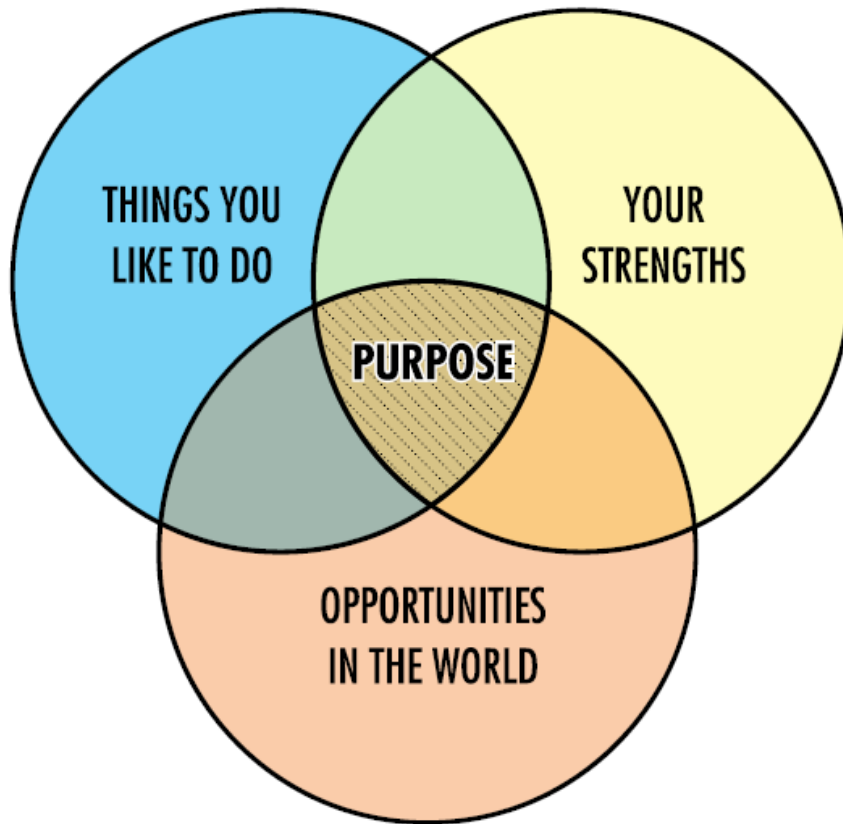

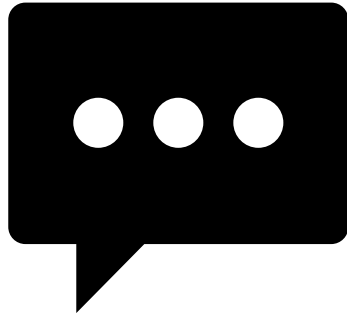

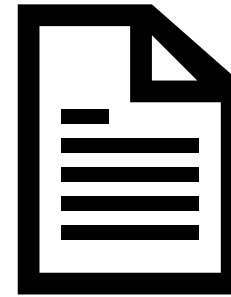

- They contribute to 20% of your grade.

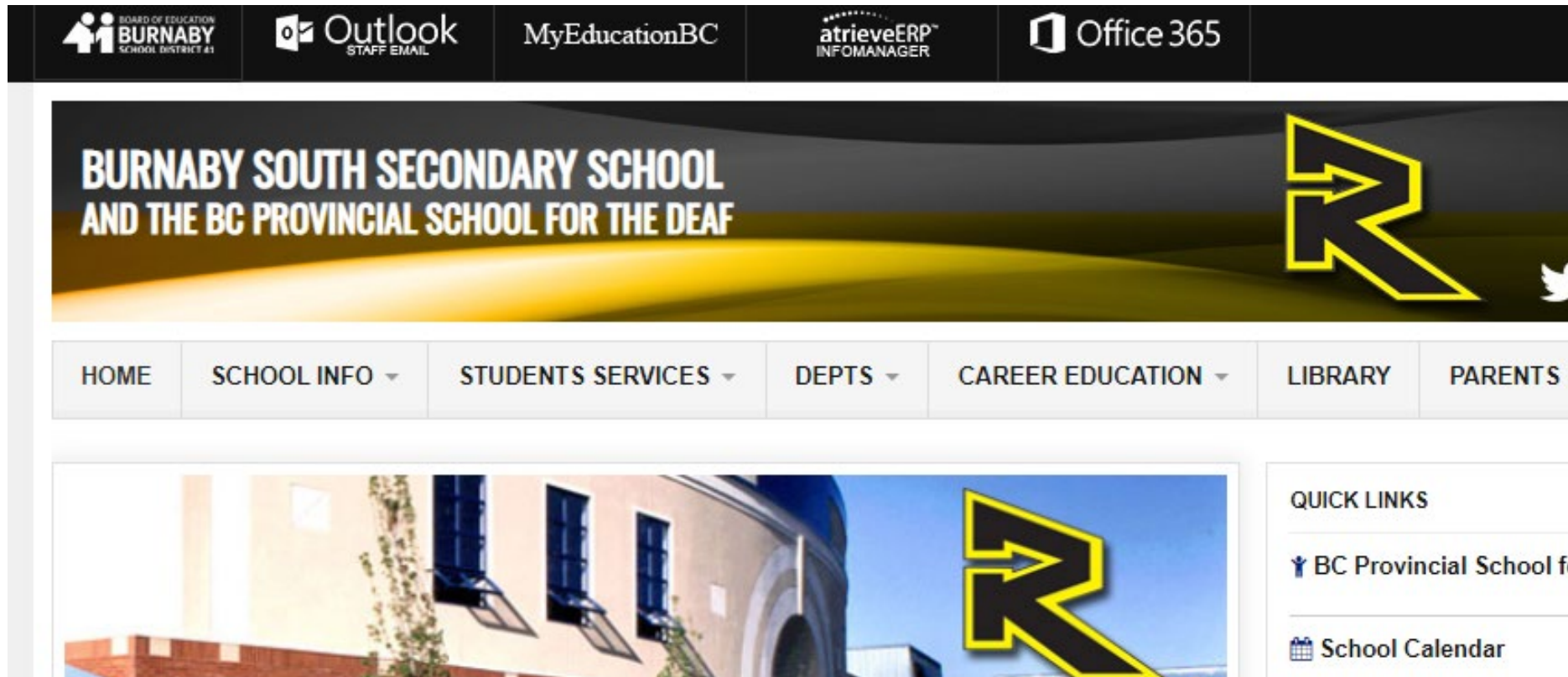
## Assignments

- Assignments contribute to 80% of your grade.



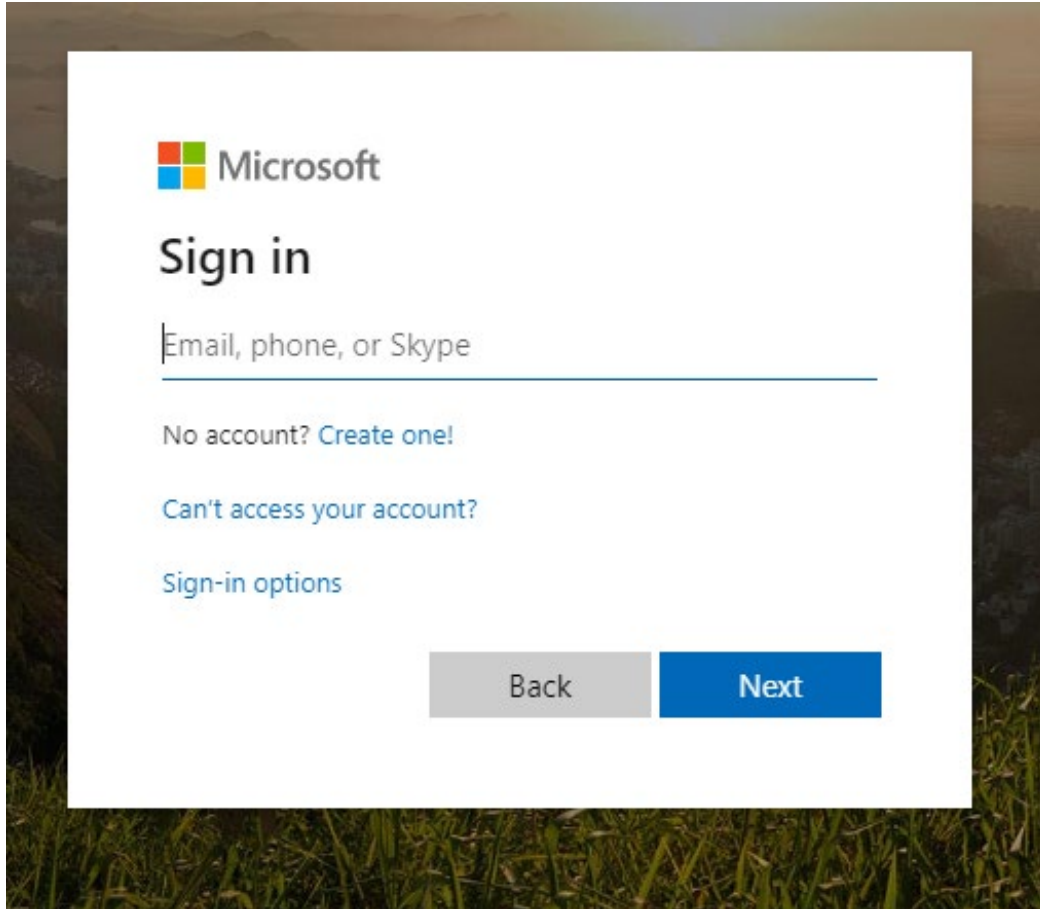

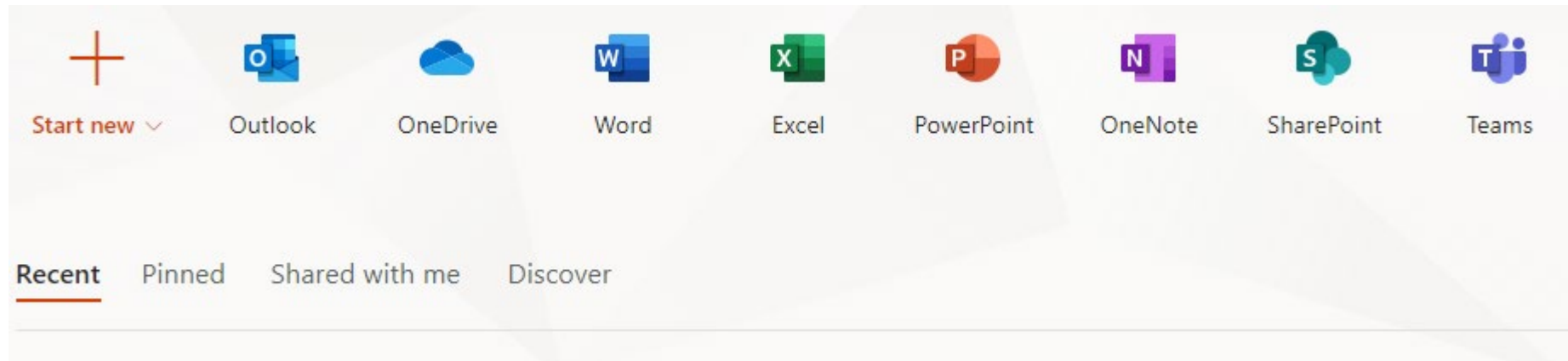

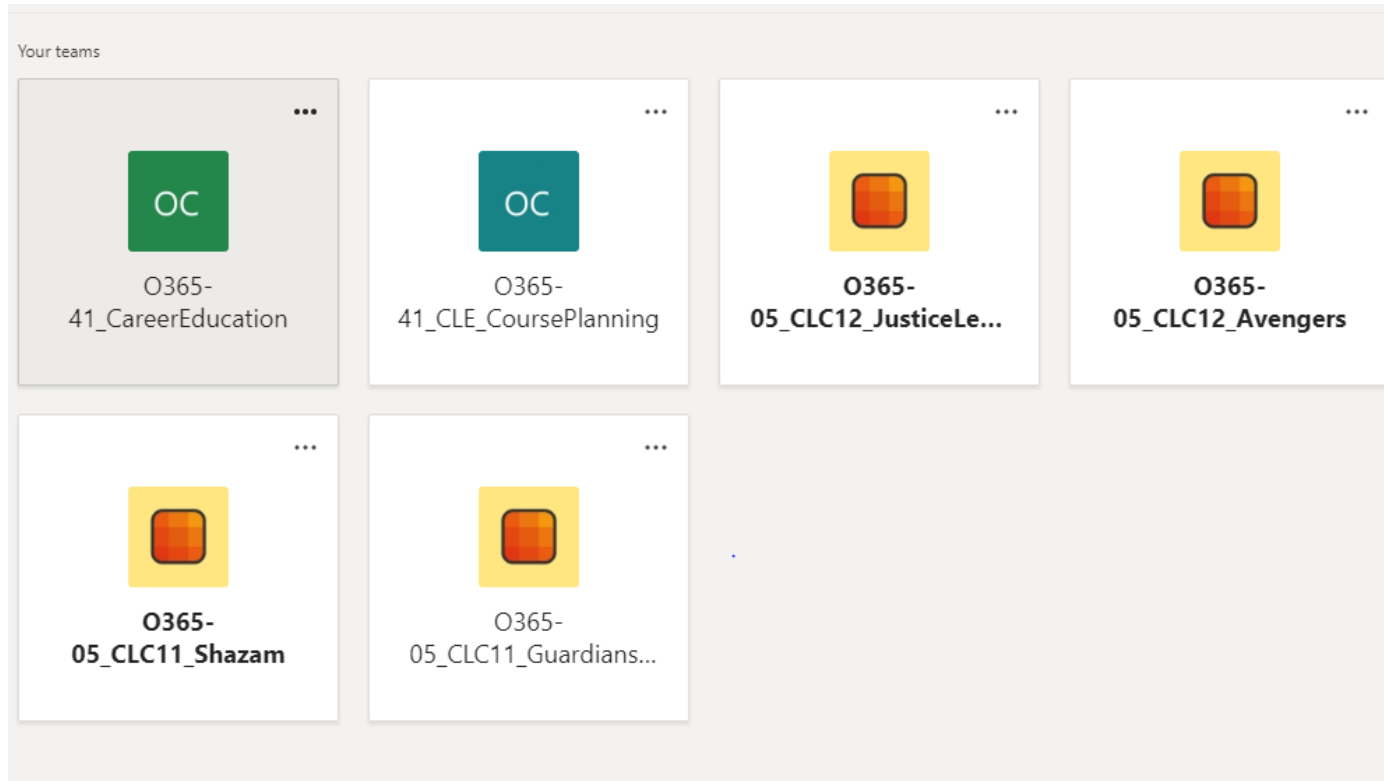
