- On your computer, open Chrome or Safari.

Drag and Drop a Picture (must use Chrome or Firefox for this option)

- 1. Open Chrome or Firefox on your computer.
- 2. Go to https://images.google.com
- 3. On your computer, find the image you want to search with.
- 4. Click on the picture.
- 5. Hold down the mouse, drag the picture, and then drop it into the search box.

Search with a URL

- 1. Open Chrome or Safari.
- 2. Go to the website that has the picture you want to use.
- 3. To copy the URL, right-click on the picture.
- 4. Click "Copy image address".
- 5. Next, go to https://images.google.com
- 6. Click "Search by image".
- 7. Click "Paste image URL".
- 8. Paste the URL in to the text box.
- 9. Click "Search by image".

Search with a Picture from a Website

- 1. Open the Chrome browser on your computer.
- 2. Go to the we site that has the picture you want to use.
- 3. Right-click on the picture.
- 4. Click "Search Google for image". You will see your results in a new tab.
