- Transcripts

**BCEA Bursary Program**

- \$500 - \$1000
- Available to Grade 12 and post-secondary students perusing a career in Electrical, Marketing, Electrical Engineering, and Business (must attend school in September full-time)

- 25 x \$4000
- Community service and leadership
- Complete application forms by August 2016

**BCSSA Grade 12 Scholarship**

- 6x \$1000
- A completed application form
- One-page description of how your volunteer service has made a difference in the life or lives of others (450 words max)
- 2 letters of reference affirming how you have improved the quality of life for others through volunteer work and/or other activities
- Demonstrated exemplary service and leadership by providing examples (2 of service and 2 of leadership)
- Official school copy of your transcript

**BCSTA Scholarship for Student Citizenship**

- 4 x \$500
- Exemplary citizenship within their school and community
- Include completed application form
- Include an essay (max 500 words) that defines what citizenship means to you personally; how the citizenship concept applies to their school and community; and describes how the student applies this concept of good citizenship in both school and community. The student may include a description of how family has been influential and supportive in helping develop their idea of citizenship.
- Include 2 sponsoring letters (one from a school official and one from a representative of a community organization)

- Writes and passes 5 provincial exams
- Achieves at least a "B" in English 12
