3) Pick in which term and which category you wish to have an assignment dropped from. As you’ll see in the photo above, Q3 (term 3) has “available” marks that can be dropped in 3 of the 4 categories. If you wanted students to have their lowest test dropped from a given term, in your “Test” category (SA- Summative Assessment) you would change the 0 to a 1 in “# to drop column. Press “save” and then you can check the status of this in the Gradebook “Scores” tab.
